- Footnotes: [i] BOB: ^x Unidentified covername. Unlikely to be identical with "BOB" (Latin spell) in LONDON No. 1684 of 11 July 1941 (3/PPDT/T108, originally issued as 3/NBF/T1438). Boris Mikhajlovich KROTOV, Soviet Third Secretary and Consul, who had some responsibility for repatriation affairs, is probably covername "BOB" in LONDON messages of September 1945.
- [ii] DZHEN: ^x Unidentified covername. Also occurs in MOSCOW's message of 12 September 1945 (3/NBF/T2079).
- [iii] ELLEN: ^x Unidentified covername. Also occurs in MOSCOW's message of 12 September 1945 (3/NBF/T2079).
