The Association of Scientific Workers of AUSTRALIA was first organised in NEW SOUTH WALES by Dr. MAKINSON [a] and a number of other members of the "FRATERNAL" [BRATSKAYA] [i]. The object of this organisation [O: was] to unite all the scientific workers of AUSTRALIA. [O: At present] it contains about 1200-1400 members. The Federal Council of the organisation is in MELBOURNE and consists of progressive [2 groups unrecovered/garbled] persons. Many of the members of the Federal Council are in the "FRATERNAL" or are under its influence. The State Councils (especially those of VICTORIA and NEW SOUTH WALES) and the Federal Council are closely interconnected and work very smoothly. The leading State on the Federal Council is N.S.W. [N. Yu. U.]. The chairman of this state's council is HIBBARD [a] - a radio physicist, works in the Government Council for Scientific and Industrial Research [KOLLEKTIV NAUCHNOGO I PROMYSHLENNOGO IZYSKANIYA], an active member of the "FRATERNAL". The leadership of the Association has not [O: taken part] in anti-Soviet manifestations. I am sending by post: a prospectus setting out in detail the aims, tasks and organisation of the Association, forms of application [O: for] admission to membership, [O: the annual report] of the Association for N.S.W. The Royal Institute of Architects [KOROLEVSKIY ARKHITECTURNYIY INSTITUT] is not an educational institution/

In addition to this it acts as a link between Australian architects. It contains an absolute majority of the architects of the country. Over a number of years the Institute has not made any appearance in political life. Of the leading members of the Institute the only one who is well known is FYNOR [a] - an architect who is progressive. On 22nd. of April there took place in JERSEY a Conference [3 groups unrecovered] [D,] in which FYNOR took part on behalf of the Institute of Architects as a consultant in architecture.
