For FEDOTOV, [1]

On 6th June 1945 356 prisoners of war were sent off to the Finnish port of RAUMA. Among them ~~96 are leaving~~ <sup>and 10 are returning</sup> 9 persons who have served in the German army and two persons, ELLYAEV, Grigorij Prokof'evich, born 1923, and KDRKHIN [10 groups unrecovered]. <sup>4 groups unrecovered. [7 groups unrecovered]</sup>

[11] APRAKSIN: Pavel Aleksandrovich KERSANOV who replaced RAZIN as Legal Resident in STOCKHOLM in 1945, <sup>and was later</sup> <sup>Secretary of the Soviet Consulate in STOCKHOLM</sup>
