- ✓ [xix] SOLOV'EVA: Aleksandra Illarionovna SOLOV'EVA, clerk/interpreter in the Soviet Military Attaché's Office, in the UK 14 July 1944 - 13 October 1948.
- ✓ [xx] RYABCHIKOV: Junior Lieutenant (or Sergeant) Vladimir Aleksandrovich RYABCHIKOV, clerk/doorkeeper in the Soviet Military Mission, later clerk on the Military Attaché's staff, in the UK 17 March 1945 - 13 October 1948 and 10 January 1949 - 15 July 1950.
- ✓ [xxi] PAVLOV: Aleksej Ivanovich PAVLOV, maintenance man/doorkeeper, attached first to the Soviet Military Attaché's office, later to the Embassy, in the UK 28 April 1944 - 1 March 1947.
- ✓ [xxii] TsYGANOV: Senior Sergeant Valentin Valentinovich TsYGANOV, chauffeur/security guard for the Soviet Military Attaché's office, in the UK 31 May 1945 - 13 August 1949.
