In connection with the present recruitment of personnel for the Secretariat of the United Nations Organisation, its committees and sub-committees, and the setting up of permanent representations of membercountries of the Organisation, report by telegraph:

1) which of the diplomatic workers and workers of other departments and public and political circles of the country in which you are residing have been appointed to work in the Secretariat of the Organisation, its committees and sub-comittees, and, if known, to what duties.

2) who has been appointed to the Permanent Representation with the United Nations Organisation of the country in which you reside and to what duties.

The above information should include the minimum of identifying data [USTANOVOCHNYE DANNYE] and short personal histories [KhARAKTERISTIKI]. Detailed personal histories

All information on this question should be based both on [D% AGENTURNA [AGENTURNYJ] information] and on official data (press reports, etc.) and should include particulars not only about persons being appointed to administrative and diplomatic work, but also about those being sent on technical work (technical secretaries, translators, cipher clerks, ctc.).
