The information you reported in no. 15[a] about ZOLOTUKHINA's [1] relations with YOUNG [YANG] merits serious attention. In connection with her recall home it is necessary to arrange for her continuous surveillance by assigning an ATHLETE [ATHLETE] to her. Make an arrangement with the ENGINEER [ENGINEER] [1] about stopping her meetings with YOUNG, [2 groups unrecovered] her with a plausible excuse [D5 in another]
