SIGINT SUMMARY 41-72 INFORMATION IN THIS REPORT IS THAT AVAILABLE TO NSA AS OF 1500 EST 17 FEBRUARY 1972 AND IS BASED ENTIRELY ON SIGINT EXCEPT WHERE OTHER- WISE SPECIFICALLY IDENTIFIED. VIETNAMESE COMMUNIST FRONT 4 TO INITIATE FRONT-WIDE ATTACKS ON 17 FEBRUARY AN ASSOCIATE OF FRONT 4 STATED THAT A FRONT-WIDE ATTACK WAS TO BEGIN AT MIDNIGHT ON 19 FEBRUARY AND EXTEND UNTIL 25 FEBRUARY. THE EMPHASIS EVIDENTLY WILL BE INDIRECT FIRE ATTACKS, AS UNITS ARE DISCUSSING THE MOVEMENT OF ROCKETS AND MORTAR SHELLS. WHILE NO SPECIFIC TARGETS WERE MENTIONED, DISTRICT UNITS WERE ADVISED THAT THEY WOULD RECEIVE THEIR TARGET LISTS BY MESSENGER. OTHER FRONT UNITS CONTINUE THEIR RECONNAISSANCE EFFORTS. (3/00/[REDACTED] R41-72) ~~(SECRET SPOKE)~~ NVA TANKS CONTINUE TO DEPLOY INFORMATION OF 16 FEBRUARY INDICATES THAT NORTH VIET- NAMESE TANK UNITS MAY HAVE MOVED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF SOUTH VIETNAM. A CONVERSATION BETWEEN TANK CREWMEN REFERRED TO A \$TOC CAN\$ (POSSIBLY TA CAN, WHICH IS LOCATED SOUTH OF DAK TO) AND THE NECESSITY FOR STOPPING TO REFUEL AND RESUP- PLY. ALTHOUGH A FIRM TACTICAL AREA OF OPERATIONS HAS NOT BE ASCERTAINED, IT IS BELIEVED THAT THESE TANKS ARE DEPLOYING ALONG NATIONAL ROUTE 14 IN KONTUM PROVINCE, SOUTH VIETNAM. PREVIOUSLY, SIGINT REVEALED THE DEPLOYMENT OF AS MANY AS 31 NVA TANKS THROUGH LAOS TOWARD SOUTH VIETNAM. (SS35-72; 2/00/VCK/R71-72) ~~(SECRET SPOKE)~~ NORTH VIETNAMESE SAM REACTION TO HOSTILE AIR ACTIVITY OVER SOUTHERN NORTH VIETNAM ON 17 FEBRUARY NORTH VIETNAMESE SAM-ASSOCIATED COMMUNICA- TIONS REFLECTED AIR DEFENSE REACTIONS TO \$HOSTILE\$ AIR ACTIVITY OVER SOUTHERN NORTH VIETNAM, RESULTING IN THE REPORTED \$[REDACTED]\$ AIRCRAFT AND THE CAPTURE OF AT LEAST THREE AIRCREW MEMBERS. THE \$[REDACTED]\$ TWO SHOOT DOWNS HAS NOT BEEN ATTRIBUTED TO ANY SPECIFIC TYPE \$[REDACTED]\$ HOWEVER, THE SECOND AIRCRAFT WAS DOWNED BY ONE SA-2 MISSILE LAUNCHED BY THE 89TH BATTALION OF THE 274TH SAM REGIMENT. THROUGHOUT THE DAY'S ACTIVITY, AT LEAST FIVE MISSILES WERE LAUNCHED BY ELEMENTS OF THE 267TH SAM REGIMENT AND THE 274TH SAM REGIMENT, BOTH OF WHICH ARE IN THE GENERAL DONG HOI VICINITY OF LOWER QUANG BINH PROVINCE. OPERATIONAL REPORTS REVEALED THAT A \$[REDACTED]\$ AND A USAF F-4 WERE LOST ON THE 17TH. IN ADDITION, SIGINT HAS CONFIRMED THAT THE 89TH RATHER THAN THE 87TH BATTALION OF THE 274TH SAM \$[REDACTED]\$ AN UNIDENTIFIED AIRCRAFT AND CAPTURED BOTH CREW MEMBERS ON \$[REDACTED]\$ (SS 48-72; 2/00/VCK/R148-72; 2/00/LSVCK/R15-72 AND FOLLOW-UPS) ~~(SECRET SPOKE)~~ NORTH VIETNAM REQUESTS ASSISTANCE IN RESTORATION OF BOMB-DAMAGED POWER PLANT POLAND AND CZECHOSLOVAKIA WERE ASKED ON 12 FEBRUARY TO ASSIST NORTH VIETNAM IN THE RESTORATION OF A 50,000 KW CAPACITY ELECTRIC POWER PLANT LOCATED NEAR THE QUANG NINH MINING REGION IN THE NORTHEAST SECTOR OF THE COUNTRY. ACCORDING TO HANOI THIS FACILITY HAD BEEN SEVERELY DAMAGED BY AMERICAN AIRCRAFT AND RECONSTRUCTION COSTS WOULD EXCEED \$1 MILLION. (2X/00/[REDACTED] R197-72)

VIETNAMESE COMMUNIST FRONT 4 TO INITIATE FRONT-WIDE ATTACKS ON 17 FEBRUARY AN ASSOCIATE OF FRONT 4 STATED THAT A FRONT-WIDE ATTACK WAS TO BEGIN AT MIDNIGHT ON 19 FEBRUARY AND EXTEND UNTIL 25 FEBRUARY. THE EMPHASIS EVIDENTLY WILL BE INDIRECT FIRE ATTACKS, AS UNITS ARE DISCUSSING THE MOVEMENT OF ROCKETS AND MORTAR SHELLS. WHILE NO SPECIFIC TARGETS WERE MENTIONED, DISTRICT UNITS WERE ADVISED THAT THEY WOULD RECEIVE THEIR TARGET LISTS BY MESSENGER. OTHER FRONT UNITS CONTINUE THEIR RECONNAISSANCE EFFORTS.
