COMMUNICATIONS REVEAL DISPOSITION OF CHRASHED AIRCRAFT  
TEXT XXCC ON 27 APRIL, TACTICAL VOICE COMMUNICATIONS BETWEEN  
UN- IDENTIFIED REAR SERVICES ELEMENTS REFLECTED POSSIBLE  
VE- HICLES MOVEMENT, THE DISPOSITION OF A DOWNED AMERICAN  
AIR- CRAFT AND THE PRESENCE OF 100-200 PERSONNEL AT AN AREA  
DESIGNATED "89" POSSIBLY NEAR A KILOMETER MARKER 34 (UN-  
LOCATED). THE MESSAGE REVEALED A LIST OF EQUIPMENT REPORTEDLY  
REMOVED FROM THE CRASHED AIRCRAFT OF A "LT COL SAFFELL"  
WHICH INCLUDED THE FOLLOWING: A SMALL RUBBER RAFT, AN INDIVIDUAL  
BANDAGE, ONE SMALL CASE OF BEER, THREE BURNED PIECES OFMAP  
OF WHICH ONE SHOWED AN AIRSTRIP, FIVE BOOKS SHOWING COMMON  
PLACENAMES IN ASIA, FOUR DAMAGED 20MM GUNS, A CASE OF AMMUNITION  
AND THE PILOTS HELMENT. TWO SEATS WERE REPORTEDLY LEFT AT  
THE AIRCRAFT. A PRIOR MESSAGE INDICATES THAT THE PILOT WAS  
PICKED UP BY A HELICOPTER. ((1)) THE MESSAGE ALSO REVEALED  
THAT ON THE NIGHT OF 27 APRIL THE "HORSES" WOULD GO INTO  
THE "TWO PARALLEL ROADS" AND IF THERE WERE NO ENEMY, THEN  
TEHE "ELEPHANTS AND HORSES" WOULD ADVANCE AS USUAL. THESE  
DESIGNATORS ARE POSSIBLE REFERENCES TO VEHICLES. SUBSEQUENT  
CONVERSATION INDICATED THAT A TROOP OF ENTAINERS WOULD PERFORM  
FOR 180-200 PERSONNEL ON 28 AND 29 APRIL AT AN AREA DESIGNATED  
89. POSSIBLE UNITS DE- SIGNATED "C-2, 101 AND C-3" WERE  
MENTIONED IN CON- JUNCTION WITH THIS LATTER ACTIVITY. ((1))
