NATIONAL SECURITY AGENCY SOUTHEAST ASIA SIGINT SUMMARY

TEXT XXCC THIS REPORT SUMMARIZES DEVELOPMENTS NOTED THROUGHOUT SOUTHEAST ASIA AVAILABLE TO NSA AS OF 1600Z, 17 FEBRUARY. ALL INFORMATION IN THIS REPORT IS BASED ENTIRELY ON SIGINT EXCEPT WHERE OTHERWISE SPECIFICALLY INDICATED. SITUATION SUMMARY VIETNAMESE COMMUNIST UNITS THROUGHOUT INDOCHINA ARE REACTING TO ALLIED ACTIVITY IN CAMBODIA AND LAOS. SEVERAL MAJOR UNITS ARE MOVING INTO AND WITHIN AREAS OF TACTICAL CONCERN. IN MR 4, NORTH VIETNAM, AN ELEMENT OF THE QUANG BINH PROVINCIAL UNIT URGED SUBORDINATES TO MAINTAIN VIGILANCE AND COMBAT READINESS AND BOASTED OF NVA SUCCESSES IN LAOS. THE ELEMENT ALSO STATED THAT THERE ARE INDICATIONS THAT THE ALLIES WERE ABOUT TO ATTACK IN ITS AREA. IN THE DMZ AREA, AN ELEMENT OF THE NVA 27B REGIMENT REPORTED RESULTS OF PREVIOUS ENCOUNTERS WITH ALLIED FORCES. COMMUNIST FORCES IN SEVERAL AREAS OF MR 5 ARE PREPARING FOR COMBAT. PREPARATIONS FOR PHASE 2 HAVE BEEN MENTIONED IN BOTH FRONT 4 AND IN BINH DINH PROVINCIAL UNIT COMMUNICATIONS. ADDITIONALLY, IN PLEIKU PROVINCE, A SERIES OF COORDINATED ATTACKS ALONG NATIONAL ROUTE 19 IS BEING PLANNED BY THE GIA LAI PROVINCIAL UNIT. ELEMENTS OF THE PROVINCIAL UNIT ARE DELIBER-ATING ON THE UNDISCLOSED OPEN-FIRE DATE OF THEIR B-81 CAMPAIGN AND ON THEIR MOVEMENT OF WEAPONS AND MUNITIONS. (ISHTAR) IN MR 2, ELEMENTS OF THE BEN TRE PROVINCIAL UNIT IN KIEN HOA PROVINCE DISCLOSED PLANS FOR =WIDESPREAD TACTICAL ACTIVITY= TO ASSIST COMMUNIST FORCES IN LAOS, CAMBODIA, AND THE BORDER AREAS OF SOUTH VIETNAM. THE STRATEGIC INTELLIGENCE BUREAU OF COSVN AGAIN REPORTED ON ALLIED ACTIVITIES IN MR 1, CAMBODIA. (ISHTAR) CAMBODIAN COMMUNICATIONS REFLECT AN INCREASE IN ENEMY ACTIVITY ALONG NATIONAL ROUTES 1 AND 7 AND IN THE VICINITY OF KOMPONG CHAM CITY IN MR 1, SCATTERED SKIRMISHES AND ENEMY HARASSMENTS THROUGHOUT MUCH OF THE REST OF THE COUNTRY, AND COMMUNIST INTENTIONS TO ATTACK SEVERAL GOVERNMENT POSITIONS IN THE SPECIAL MR. ADDITIONALLY, =A LARGE NUMBER= OF VC, REPORTEDLY FROM A 10,000-MAN FORCE, IS THREATENING TO ATTACK THE CAMBODIAN POSITION AT TAING KAU. (~~SECRET SPOKE ISHTAR~~) XXH 400

TEXT XXCC I. LAOS/SOUTH VIETNAM REACTIONS TO ALLIED OPERATIONS IN LAOS REPORTS EXTOLLING COMBAT VICTORIES IN THE CURRENT ALLIED OPERATIONS IN LAOS CONTINUE TO BE THE SUBJECT OF GENERAL DIRECTORATE OF REAR SERVICES (GDRS) COMMUNICATIONS EMANATING FROM THAT AREA, AND ARE SUMMARIZED AS FOLLOWS: THE 17TH BATTALION, 282D AAA REGIMENT, WAS CREDITED WITH THE DOWNING OF TWO ALLIED AIRCRAFT; THE 44TH BATTALION OF BINH TRAM (BT) 34 (HQ LOCATED WEST OF ROUTE 92E) REPORTEDLY SHOT DOWN AN F4 AND SHOT AND BURNED ANOTHER AIRCRAFT; ONE COMMUNICATIONS INDIVIDUAL OF THE 591ST AAA REGIMENT HAD =SINGLE-HANDEDLY= SHOT DOWN A HELICOPTER; TWO INFANTRY SQUADS AT HIGH POINT (HP) 550 HAD SHOT DOWN MANY AIRCRAFT; A 9TH INFANTRY BATTALION HAD USED GROUND =MISSILES= TO DESTROY TWO TANKS; AN =INFANTRY GROUP X= HAD ALLEGEDLY ATTACKED THREE ALLIED BATTALIONS ON PROBABLY ROUTE 35, DESTROYING ONE AND ROUTING THE OTHER; AND AN UNIDENTIFIED UNIT REPORTEDLY USED EXPLOSIVES TO DESTROY FOUR TANKS AND TO =SMASH THE ENEMY OFFENSIVE.= FURTHER COMBAT ACHIEVEMENTS WERE REPORTED IN OTHER EMULATIVE MESSAGES, AS FOLLOWS: THE 26TH COMPANY OF THE 20TH AAA BATTALION HAD DOWNED THREE HU-1A HELICOPTERS; THE 591ST AAA BATTALION HAD SHOT DOWN FOUR HELICOPTERS ALONG ROUTE 16 AND HAD KILLED AND CAPTURED 200 =ENEMY=; AN UNIDENTIFIED ELEMENT REPORTED THAT THE =ENEMY ATTACK= HAD BEEN REPULSED AND THAT TWO SQUADS HAD SHOT DOWN EIGHT HELICOPTERS; AND FINALLY, A REPORT FROM VARIOUS BINH TRAM DISCLOSED THAT 589 =ENEMY= HAD BEEN KILLED, 68 AIRCRAFT, 15 TANKS, 6 ARTILLERY PIECES AND A COMMUNICATIONS CENTER HAD BEEN DESTROYED. ANTICIPATED ALLIED TROOP LANDINGS IN PROBABLY THE BT 32 (WD 9762, 16-50N 105-55E) AREA WERE REPORTED BY THE 12TH AAA BATTALION. REPORTEDLY THE =ENEMY= WOULD LAND TROOPS IN AT LEAST THE AREAS OF HP'S 639 AND 659 (BOTH UNLOCATED) ON 14 FEBRUARY. EVERY EFFORT TO SMASH THIS PLOT TO LAND TROOPS WAS TO BE MADE. THE 12TH BATTALION, IN ANOTHER REPORT TO ITS SUBORDINATE ELEMENTS, ALSO OUTLINED DETAILS OF ALLIED AIRBORNE LANDING TECHNIQUES. IN A 13 FEBRUARY MESSAGE, THE 12TH AAA BATTALION REVEALED THAT THE PARTY COMMITTEE AND THE BT 32 COMMANDER WERE LAUNCHING A TRANSPORTATION =GENERAL OFFENSIVE= PHASE FROM 11 FEBRUARY UNTIL THE END OF THE MONTH. EVERY NIGHT DURING FEBRUARY, APPROXIMATELY 200-250 VEHICLES WERE REPORTEDLY TO PASS THROUGH THE AREA. RECENTLY AVAILABLE SIGINT OF 12 FEBRUARY HAS REVEALED THAT ON THAT DATE THE HQ, BT 41 WAS IN A SERIOUS SITUATION AND WAS UNDER GROUND ATTACK. THIS INFORMATION WAS TRANSMITTED TO THE HQ, 559TH TRANSPORTATION GROUP (TG) ON ITS COMMAND =WATCH= FACILITY. THE HQ, BT 41 WAS LOCATED ON 1 JANUARY, APPROXIMATELY 35 KM SOUTHEAST OF TCHEPONE NEAR XD 727257 (16-30N 106-36E). THIS ACTIVITY IS PROBABLY RELATED TO THE CURRENT ALLIED INCURSION INTO LAOS. A 16 FEBRUARY MESSAGE BETWEEN ELEMENTS OF THE NVA 675B ARTILLERY REGIMENT INDICATES THAT THESE FORCES MAY PARTICIPATE IN ATTACKS BY FIRE AGAINST A NUMBER OF ALLIED POSITIONS IN THE BORDER AREA NEAR ROUTE 9. THE MESSAGE MENTIONED =ANNIHILATING THE ENEMY ON A NUMBER OF IMPORTANT POINTS.= THESE REPORTED INCLUDED HILL 500 (UNLOCATED) AND POSSIBLY A HILL 400 (POSSIBLY XD 5047, 16-42N 106-24E OR XD 5151, 16-44N 106-25E). RECENT COMMUNICATIONS ASSOCIATED WITH THE POSSIBLE 3D BATTALION, 765B ARTILLERY REGIMENT HAVE DISCUSSED AMMUNITION RESUPPLY, AND IN A 15 FEBRUARY MESSAGE, REFERENCE WAS MADE TO POSSIBLE AMMUNITION DELIVERY TO BAN NA THONG (WD 8436, 16-37N 105-47E). IN ANOTHER MESSAGE ON THE SAME DAY, THE BATTALION'S 11TH COMPANY REPORTED THAT A VEHICLE TOWING AN ARTILLERY PIECE TO BAN NA LAI (POSSIBLY AT WD 8436, 16-37N 105-47E). IN EASTERN SAVANNAKHET PROVINCE ON 16 FEBRUARY, AN ELEMENT OF THE 24TH REGIMENT, NVA 304TH DIVISION REPORTED THAT =APPROXIMATELY ONE PLATOON= OF ALLIED TROOPS WAS MOVING TOWARD TA MAY (UNLOCATED). THE ELEMENT EXPRESSED ITS INTENT TO =ATTACK IF THE ((ALLIED)) UNIT HAS NO VEHICLES, EVEN IF IT IS LARGER THAN A COMPANY.= XXHH 900 #3241

XXCC ON 16 FEBRUARY, AN ELEMENT OF THE 64TH REGIMENT, NVA 320TH DIVISION FILED A DETAILED REPORT ON THREE ALLIED POSITIONS. ACCORDING TO THE REPORT, ONE AREA IS LOCATED 100 METERS FROM THE JUNCTION OF ROUTE 9 (POSSIBLY AT BAN DONG XD 510380, 16-37N 106-25E) AND CONTAINS COMMUNICATIONS TRENCHES AND WEAPONS SURROUNDED BY WIRE FENCES. A SECOND AREA IS LOCATED AT THE INTER-SECTION AT BAN KENG (XD 500390, 16-38N 106-24E) AND CONTAINS FOUR TANKS, TWO BULLDOZERS, AND APPROXIMATELY TWO COMPANIES OF ALLIED TROOPS. THE REPORT NOTED THERE ARE NO FENCES AT THIS SECOND AREA, AND THAT THE ALLIED THERE SLEEP UNDER THEIR VEHICLES AT NIGHT. TWENTY-FIVE TANKS AND A HELICOPTER LANDING ZONE ARE REPORTEDLY LOCATED AT A THIRD ALLIED POSITION 1 KM FROM BAN KENG. THE HQ, NVA 308TH DIVISION WAS LOCATED IN EASTERN SAVANNAKHET PROVINCE ON 16 FEBRUARY AT XD 654508 (16-43N 106-33E), IN PROXIMITY TO THE 10 FEBRUARY POSITION OF ITS SUBORDINATE HQ, 88TH REGIMENT. COMMUNICATIONS OF THE DIVISION'S 102D AND 36TH REGIMENTS INDICATE THESE UNITS ARE ALSO IN OR ENROUTE TO LAOS. ACTIVATION OF COMMUNICATIONS ON 9 FEBRUARY BETWEEN THE HQ, 102D REGIMENT, LAST LOCATED IN HA TINH PROVINCE, NORTH VIETNAM, AND THE UNIDENTIFIED MAJOR NVA HEADQUARTERS (B7728), LOCATED IN EASTERN SAVANNAKHET PROVINCE, SUGGESTS THE REGIMENT IS MOVING INTO THE TACTICAL AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY OF THE MAJOR HEADQUARTERS. MEANWHILE, HQ, 36TH REGIMENT, ALSO LAST LOCATED IN HA TINH PROVINCE, INDICATED TO DIVISION HEADQUARTERS ON 12 AND 13 FEBRUARY ITS INTENTION TO MOVE. ON 6 FEBRUARY AN ASSOCIATE (B7956) OF THE UNIDENTIFIED MAJOR NVA HEADQUARTERS (B7728) INITIATED COMMUNICATIONS WITH HIGH COMMAND OF THE ARMED FORCES, NORTH VIETNAM ON THE SOUTH VIETNAM RELATED NET. THIS ASSOCIATE WAS LOCATED ON 8 FEBRUARY AT XD 641710 (16-54N 106-32E) ON THE LAOS-DMZ BORDER, AND HAS BEEN NOTED IN WATCH COMMUNICATIONS WITH THE UNIDENTIFIED MAJOR NVA HEADQUARTERS SINCE 3 FEBRUARY. WERE TRANSMITTED TO HANOI FOR RELAY TO COSVN, THE REGION 5 PARTY COMMITTEE, AND THE PROBABLE REGION TRI-THIEN-HUE PARTY COMMITTEE

(SECRET SPOKE) 2. DMZ AREA PN THE CENTRAL DMZ AREA ON 16 FEBRUARY AN ELEMENT OF THE NVA 27B REGIMENT REPORTED THAT DURING A STRIKE CONDUCTED ON 15 FEBRUARY, THE 2D COMPANY (POSSIBLY OF THE 27B REGIMENT) KILLED 45 ALLIED TROOPS, CAPTURED TWO AUTOMATIC RIFLES, SHOT DOWN ONE AIRCRAFT AND DAMAGED ONE HEAVY MACHINEGUN. THE LOCATION OF THE STRIKE WAS NOT SPECIFIED. ALSO ON 16 FEBRUARY AN ELEMENT OF THE REGIMENT REPORTED KILLING 20 =ENEMY= DURING AN ATTACK IN THE AREA OF LANG TRE (XD 956605, 16-49N 106-50E). ANOTHER MESSAGE ON 16 FEBRUARY DISCLOSED THAT ALLIED PARATROOPS WERE OPERATING TO THE SOUTHEAST OF ROUTE 71, AND THAT IN THE AREA OF MIET XA (XD 805478, 16-42N 106-41E) THERE WAS AN ALLIED MECHANIZED DETACHMENT. (2/F1/VCM/T1360-71, 161712Z) (SECRET SPOKE) 3. MILITARY REGION 5 PREPARATIONS FOR PHASE 2 OF THE K-800 CAMPAIGN ARE STILL THE MAIN TOPIC OF DISCUSSION IN COMMUNICATIONS EMANATING FROM FRONT 4'S AREA OF OPERATIONS IN QUANG NAM PROVINCE. IN A 13 FEBRUARY MESSAGE, AN UNIDENTIFIED ASSOCIATE OF THE 575TH ARTILLERY BATTALION REPORTED THAT D-DAY WOULD COMMENCE AT 2000(G) ON THE NIGHT OF 20 FEBRUARY. MEANWHILE, THE DIEN BAN DISTRICT UNIT WAS ORDERED ON THE 17TH TO PICK UP GRENADES, SATCHEL CHARGES AND ANTI-PERSONNEL MINES PROBABLY FOR USE DURING PHASE 2. DOWN THE COAST, BINH DINH PROVINCIAL UNIT (PU) COMMUNICATIONS ARE ALSO REFERRING TO PREPARATIONS FOR PHASE 2, THOUGH IN THIS PROVINCE THE CURRENT COMBAT CAMPAIGN IS DESIGNATED H-2 AND MAY BE SCHEDULED TO BEGIN ON THE NIGHT OF 20-21 FEBRUARY. ONE PROVINCIAL UNIT SUBORDINATE, THE PHU MY DISTRICT UNIT, WAS DIRECTED ON THE 16TH TO REPORT

TEXT XXCC MOVING WEST TO NORTHEASTERN PLEIKU PROVINCE, A SERIES OF COORDINATED ATTACKS ALONG NATIONAL ROUTE 19 IS BEING PLANNED BY ELEMENTS OF THE 2D BATTALION, GIA LAI PU. SEVERAL ELEMENTS HAVE BEEN ORDERED TO COORDINATE NO LATER THAN 17 FEBRUARY IN BALANCED ATTACKS ON ALLIED CONVOYS, AND, ALTHOUGH THE COMMUNISTS HAVE EXPRESSED A PREFERENCE THAT SUPPLY TRUCKS BE THE TARGET OF THESE ATTACKS, TANKS WERE MENTIONED AS AN ACCEPTABLE SUBSTITUTE. RECONNAISSANCE AND PREPARATIONS FOR AN ATTACK ON THE HA TAM BRIDGE (BR 261471, 13-59N 108-28E) WERE DISCUSSED BY THE GIA LAI PU IN MESSAGES OF 15 AND 16 FEBRUARY; THE DESTRUCTION OF THIS BRIDGE 20 KM WEST OF AN KHE COULD SERIOUSLY DISRUPT ALLIED CONVOYS BETWEEN PLEIKU AND AN KHE. FINALLY, ELEMENTS OF THE PROVINCIAL UNIT ALSO DISCUSSED THE MOVEMENT OF WEAPONS AND MUNITIONS AND OTHER PREPARATIONS FOR THE STILL UNDISCLOSED OPEN-FIRE DATE OF THE B-81 CAMPAIGN. (ISHTAR) IN THE TRI-BORDER AREA, HQ, NVA 28TH REGIMENT WAS LOCATED AT YB 698168 (14-37N 107-30E) ON 16 FEBRUARY, 23 KM SOUTH-SOUTHWEST OF ITS 11 FEBRUARY LOCATION AT YB 764271 (14-42N 107-34E). NAM BO SUBREGIONS AN ELEMENT (I0035) OF THE POSSIBLE 7TH MILITARY INTELLIGENCE COMPANY, MILITARY INTELLIGENCE BUREAU, COSVN, WAS LOCATED ON 16 FEBRUARY AT XT 332523 (11-19N 106-13E) IN CENTRAL TAY NINH PROVINCE, 23 KM NORTHEAST OF ITS 13 JANUARY LOCATION IN SOUTHWESTERN TAY NINH PROVINCE. ~~(SECRET SPOKE)~~ 5. MILITARY REGION 2 ELEMENTS OF THE BEN TRE PROVINCIAL UNIT IN KIEN HOA PROVINCE REVEALED PLANS FOR "WIDESPREAD TACTICAL ACTIVITY" DESIGNED TO "REINFORCE" COMMUNIST EFFORTS IN OTHER AREAS OF INDOCHINA. 

AN UNIDENTIFIED ELEMENT URGENTLY REQUESTED THE 174TH REGIMENT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL TRANSPORTATION AND MEDICAL PERSONNEL FOR THE =MANY WOUNDED= THAT WERE ARRIVING AT A MEDICAL FACILITY NEAR LONG CHENG. HENCEFORTH, THE COMMAND POST, 174TH REGIMENT WILL CARRY THE DESIGNATOR B0016; IT WAS LAST LOCATED ON 14 FEBRUARY AT TG 756287 (19-13N 102-51E), 7 KM NORTHWEST OF SAM THONG. RECENT COMMUNICATIONS FROM ELEMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE NVA 25TH ENGINEER BATTALION, WORKCAMP 5 INDICATE THAT THE BATTALION IS FUNCTIONING IN A DIRECT SUPPORT ROLE TO NVA ARTILLERY UNITS OPERATING SOUTHWEST OF THE PLAINE DES JARRES. A MESSAGE OF 13 FEBRUARY FROM THE 25TH BATTALION TO ITS SUBORDINATE 3D COMPANY CONTAINED INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE COMPANY TO TRANSPORT PERFORATED STEEL PLANKING POSSIBLY INTO A CHECKPOINT AT BAN MI (UG 0047, 19-25N 103-06E). STEEL PLANKING, IN THE PAST, HAS BEEN UTILIZED TO COMBAT MUDDY CONDITIONS ALONG TRANSPORTATION ROUTES. THE COMPANY WAS FURTHER INSTRUCTED TO COORDINATE WITH THE ARTILLERY SECTION FROM =N23 ((TG 9742, 19-20N 103-04E)) INTO THE DIRECTION OF MUONG PHANG. = ALTHOUGH THERE IS A MUONG PHANH AT TG 9950 (19-26N 103-05E), NORTH OF BAN MI, IT IS MORE LIKELY THAT THE LOCATION REFERRED TO IN THIS MESSAGE IN MUONG PANG (TG 9236, 19-18N 103-00E)-- WHICH IS EAST OF BAN NA AND HAS BEEN THE SCENE OF HEAVY COMMUNIST ARTILLERY ATTACKS. ANOTHER 13 FEBRUARY MESSAGE BETWEEN UNIDENTIFIED SUBORDINATES OF THE 25TH BATTALION REPORTED THAT ARTILLERY WAS ENTERING BAN NA LOUANG (TG 9841, 19-20N 103-04E) AND THAT =WE HAVE THE MISSION OF PROTECTING THAT ROAD.= POSSIBLY RELATED TO THIS ACTIVITY WAS A 15 FEBRUARY MESSAGE IN WHICH ELEMENTS OF THE 316TH DIVISION'S 14TH AAA BATTALION DISCUSSED THE NEED FOR PERSONNEL TO BE SENT TO NA LOUANG TO RECEIVE ROCKETS =FOR FIRING ON P11= (UNLOCATED). EARLIER MESSAGES HAD INDICATED THAT ELEMENTS OF THIS BATTALION WERE INVOLVED IN RECONNAISSANCE ACTIVITY IN THE MUONG POT REGION, WEST OF NA LOUANG. IN LUANG PRABANG PROVINCE, RECENTLY AVAILABLE COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVED FROM A SPECIAL SOURCE AND TENTATIVELY ASSOCIATED WITH THE NVA 335TH INDEPENDENT REGIMENT HVE PROVIDE ADDITIONL INFORMATION ON NVA PLNNING FOR TACOK RR ZNZ DE PP/
