FURTHER ANALYSIS OF DRV MULTICHANNEL [REDACTED] RADIO
RELAY COMMS INTERCEPTED ON 24 APR 66 BETWEEN 0805-0902Z
REVEALS THAT ONE U. S. ACFT WAS DESTROYED SHORTLY AFTER 0811Z
BY THE SECOND OF TWO CONSECUTIVELY FIRED MISSILES LAUNCHED
FROM A SAM SITE LOCATED APPROX 2118N 10604E. DETONATION TOOK
PLACE AT 354 DEG, 6.5 NM FROM THE -SITE, AND THE SHOOTDOWN WAS
REPORTEDLY CONFIRMED BY VISUAL OBSERVERS AT A
NEARBY AAA SITE. THE DESTROYED ACFT WAS DESCRIBED AS ONE OF
FOUR. THE REMAINING THREE ACFT WERE REPORTED TO HAVE FLOWN
AWAY.

THE TARGET WAS ACQUIRED BY THE SAM SITE SHORTLY BEFORE
0810Z. THE ORDER TO DESTROY THE TARGET WAS ISSUES AT APPROX
0811Z. TRACKING CONTINUED ON THE THREE OTHER ACFT. THEY MADE
AN APPROX 180 DEG LEFT TURN AT 0814Z AND FWEL OUT OF RANGE TO
THE NORTH AT 0817Z

A POST-LAUNCH REPORT GIVEN BETWEEN 0831-0915Z SUPPLIED
DETAILS OF THE LAUNCH. OTHER ITEMS NOTED IN THE REPORT WERE
(1) THE DESTROYED ACFT CAME DOWN 5.3 NM FROM THE SITE (2) AAA
SITES WERE ACTIVE AND FIRED POSS 183 ROUNDS, AND WERE PREPARED
QUOTE TO BATTLE AGAIN UNQUOTE A AND (3) BOMBS WERE DROPPED BY
THE ACFT
