According to figures as yet incomplete, during the two months [of April and May] the Armed Self-Defense Forces, during skirmishes with the enemy, killed approximately 1,000, wounded 3,770 evil rangers, and captured 712. Among these casualties, (C percent 5) American aggressors were killed or wounded, and four were captured. During the anti-sweep action in Kien Tuong [Province] on 25 May [1962] alone, the
