TWO HOSTILE AIRCRAFT POSSIBLY DOWNED BY SAM
ANALYSIS OF DRV MULTICHANNEL [REDACTED] COMMUNICATIONS
INTERCEPTED ON 1 AUG 66 BETWEEN 0015Z TO 1018Z, HAS REVEALED
THE POSSIBLE DESTRUCTION OF TWO HOSTILE AIRCRAFT BY ONE AND POSSIBLY
THE UNIDENTIFIED DRV SAM SITES.

THE FIRST AIRCRAFT WAS POSSIBLY DOWNED BY ONE SURFACE-TO-AIR
MISSILE LAUNCHED AT APPROXIMATELY 0722Z. THE MISSILE REPORTEDLY
EXPLODED AT A DISTANCE OF 9.2 NMS FROM THE SITE AFTER BEING LAUNCHED
AT AN AZIMUTH OF 320 DEGREES. THE TARGET WAS SAID TO BE HIT AND
WAS LGST ON RADAR 8.1 NMS FROM THE SITE AT AN AZIMUTH OF 315 DEGREES.

TWO OTHER MISSILES WERE POSSIBLY LAUNCHED AT 0806 30Z FROM
EITHER THE SAME OR ANOTHER UNIDENTIFIED SAM SITE. THE FIRST
MISSILE WAS LAUNCHED AT A RANGE OF 13.6 NMS ON AN AZIMUTH OF 325
DEGREES BUT WAS REPORTED TO QUOTE NOT HAVE GUIDANCE UNDUCTE. THE
SECOND MISSILE WAS LAUNCHED AT AN AZIMUTH OF 323 DEGREES AT
A SITE TO TARGET RANGE OF 10.8 NMS. THIS SAM EXPLODED 13.6 NMS
NORTHWEST OF THE SITE AT AN ALTITUDE OF 8200 FT. THE TARGET
TURNED LEFT IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE EXPLOSION AND WAS LGST (ON RADAR)
AT A RANGE OF 14.2 NMS FROM THE SITE ON AN AZIMUTH OF 320 DEGREES.
THIS AIRCRAFT POSSIBLY WENT DOWN IN THE VICINITY OF TAM DACR MOUNTAINS
(21-27N 105-35E).

COMMENTS

ANALYSIS OF DATA REPORTED INDICATES
THAT THE SITE OR SITES RESPONSIBLE FOR THE LAUNCHES ARE LOCATED
IN THE PHUC YEN AREA. ONLY VIETNAMESE VOICE WAS NOTED IN THIS
ACTIVITY. FURTHER INFORMATION WILL BE FORWARDED AS IT BECOMES
AVAILABLE.
