PRELIMINARY AIR ACTIVITY REPORT

XXCC INFORMATION CONTAINED HEREIN REPRESENTS PRELIMINARY ANALYSIS OF SIGINT AVAILABLE TO USJ-794 FOR 03, 04 AND 05 MAY 1967. SECTION ONE CH SUMMARY OF AIR DEFENSE AND TACTICAL AIR ACTIVITY. FURTHER HIGHLIGHTING ACTIVITY FOR 03 MAQ WAS THE DRV MULTI-CHANNELS REFLECTIONS OF THE LAUNCHING OF SIX SURFACE-TO-AIR MISSILES (SAM). DURING THIS ACTIVITY REFERENCE WAS MADE TO U.S. SAR ACTIVITY (SEE SECTION 2: 1A). MULTICHANNEL COMMUNICATIONS ALSO REFLECTED THE PLANS FOR A BI-LEVEL COMMAND EXERCISE TO TAKE PLACE OF 04 MAY (SEE SECTION 2: 1B). HIGHLIGHTING ACTIVITY FOR 04 MAY WAS THE DRV MULTICHANNEL REFLECTIONS OF DAMAGE TO A SAM SITE, PROBABLY LOCATED AT 1945N10553E, BY US. NAVY AIRCRAFT (SEE SECTION 2: A). THE 238TH SAM REGIMENTAL CONTROLLER PASSED A CONGRATULATORY MESSAGE TO TWO SAM BATTALIONS WHO HAD SHOT-DOWN A U.S. AIRCRAFT ON 02 MAY AND HAD SUBSEQUENTLY CAPTURED THE DOWNED PILOT(S) (SEE SECTION 2: 2B). DRV MULTICHANNEL COMMUNICATIONS ALSO REFLECTED A NATIVE RUSSIAN CONFIRMING A CONDITION ONE ALERT AND RELAYING TRACKING DATA (SETEDRMTIN 2: 2C). THERE WERE NO AVAILABLE SIGINT REFLECTIONS CONFIRMING ACTUAL SAM LAUNCH ACTIVITY FOR THIS DATE. COMINT REFLECTED 12 ACTIVE SAM BATTALIONS: WHILE THREE ELINT IMPACTS WERE OBTAINED [REDACTED] CONTINUING TO HIGHLIGHT 04 MAY ACTIVITY WERE THE DEFENSIVE PATROLS PERFORMED BY MIGS, STAGING FROM TWO DRV AIRFIELDS, IN REACTION TO USAF P.M. STRIKE AIRCRAFT. IN A RESULTING ENGAGEMENT ONE MIG-21 WAS DESTROYED BY A MISSILE LAUNCHED BY AN F4C (SEE SECTION THREE). A MINIMUM OF 23 MIG SORTIES WERE FLOWN AND ACTIVITY, OTHER THAN REPORTED ABOVE, CONSISTED OF INTER-AIRFIELD FLIGHTS, NIGHT OPERATIONAL TRAINING, AND UNIDENTIFIED FLIGHT ACTIVITY. SIGINT REFLECTED 24 ACTIVE RADAR STATIONS USING 35 PIECES OF RADAR EQUIPMENT. INTERCEPT OF DRV AIR SURVEILLANCE FACILITIES (ASF) INDICATES THAT 14 OF THESE STATIONS REPORTED 335 TRACKS. SIGINT ALSO REFLECTED TEN ACTIVE NAVAL RADAR STATIONS TRACKING SIX AIRCRAFT AND 149 SURFACE VESSELS. SECTION TWO - SAM ACTIVITY ON 03 AND 04 MAY. 1. MAY 03: A. FROM 0609Z TO 0635Z, DRV MULTICHANNEL COMMUNICATIONS

REFLECTED THE UNSUCCESSFUL LAUNCHING OF SIX SAMs BY THREE UNIDENTIFIED/UNLOCATED SAM BATTALIONS. AT 0611Z, A SPEAKER, PROBABLY THE 238TH SUB-RTK CONTROL CENTER, INSTRUCTED AN UNIDENTIFIED BATTALION TO TURN ON HIS FANSONG, AND AT 0613Z, TO LAUNCH TWO MISSILES AGAINST A TARGET FLYING AT 4,900 FEET. AT 0614:57Z, THE SPEAKER AT THE UNIDENTIFIED BATTALION REPORTED LAUNCHING TWO MISSILES. THESE MISSILES WERE ONLY UNIDENTIFIED IN DESTROYING THE TARGET AS THE CONTROLLER INSTRUCTED THE BATTALION TO LAUNCH AGAIN. NO FURTHER LAUNCHES WERE NOTED

BY THIS BATTALION. AT 0617Z, THE CONTROLLER STATED THAT ANOTHER UN-IDENTIFIED BATTALION HAD LAUNCHED TWO MISSILES. SHORTLY THERE-AFTER, THE CONTROLLER INFORMED THE SPEAKER AT THE FIRST UNIDENTIFIED BATTALION THAT THE ENEMY IS "STRIKING". AT 0618Z, THE UNIDENTIFIED BATTALION ASKED IF THERE WERE MIG AIRCRAFT IN THE AREA. AT 0625Z, THE CONTROLLER CONFIRMED THE ABSENCE OF MIG AIR-CRAFT AND ASIL FOR THE RESULTS OF A PREVIOUS LAUNCH. AT 0627Z, THE SPEAKER AT THE UNIDENTIFIED BATTALION REPORTED THAT A HELICOPTER WAS ATTEMPTING TO RESCUE A DOWNED PILOT AND THAT FOUR AIR-CRAFT WERE ORBITING THE SAME AREA FOR PROTECTION. AT 0628Z, THE SPEAKER AT THE UNIDENTIFIED BATTALION STATED THAT A THIRD UNIDENTIFIED BATTALION HAD LAUNCHED TWO MISSILES. THERE WERE NO FURTHER REFLECTIONS OF SAM LAUNCH ACTIVITY BY THESE BATTALIONS. OPERATIONAL DATA INDICATES THAT U.S. V. PILOTS REPORTED SIGHTING SIX MISSILES ON 03 MAY: HOWEVER, THE LACK OF IDENTIFICATION OF THE BATTALIONS REFLECTED IN THE ABOVE MULTICHANNEL COMMUNICATIONS PRECLUDES CORRELATIONS TO THESE SIGHTINGS. 900
