THE FOLLOWING IS A SUMMARY F SIGINT/COLLATERAL REFLECTIONS OF DRV AIR DEFENSE AND FLIGHT ACTIVITY FOR THE PERIOD 14 THROUGH 20 OCTOBER 1967. SECTION ONE - HIGHLIGHTS. 1. BETWEEN #9#00-26Z 14 OCT, U.S. PILOTS ON STRIKES AGAINST KEP AIRFIELD AND KEP AREA REPORTED SIGHTING 1# SAMS. ONE AIRCRAFT RECEIVED SLIGHT DAMAGE FROM SAM FRAGMENTS. 2. BETWEEN #33#-41Z 17 OCT, 32 [] THE LANGGIA AND DAP CAU RR YARDS. PILOTS REPORTED THAT AAA [] LANG GIA WAS LIGHT TO MODERATE, BUT THAT AAA AT DAP CAU WAS [] AND ACCURATE. THREE F-105'S WERE DOWNED BY AAA IN THE VICINITY [] DURING THE #9#0Z, HOUR, ON 18 OCT, NEAR THE HAIPHONG BOAT YARD, SIX SAMS WERE SIGHTED. ONE A4E WAS LOST TO UN-KNOWN CAUSES DURING THIS TIME FRAME. SECTION TWO - FIGHTER ACTIVITY. 1. PHUC YEN A TOTAL OF 71 MIG SORTIES WERE PREFLIGHTED FROM THIS AIRFIELD AND AT LEAST 74 WERE FLOWN, INCLUDING 7 BY SOVIET PILOTS AND 5 BY KORCOM PILOTS. THIS IS A SLIGHT INCREASE OVER THE 63 THAT WERE FLOWN LAST WEEK. A. VIETNAMESE ACTIVITY. ACTIVITY CONSISTED OF TWO INTER-AIRFIELD FLIGHTS TO YUNNANI, CHINA, DEFENSIVE PATROLS IN REACTION TO HOSTILE AIRCRAFT, FORMATION PRACTICE AND UNIDENTIFIED FLIGHT ACTIVITY DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS, AND GCI PRACTICE, UNIDENTIFIED FLIGHT ACTIVITY DURING HOURS OF DARKNESS. ON 18 OCT, DURING THE #3#00Z HOUR, DRV AIR SURVEILLANCE (ASF) AND TACTICAL VOICE FACILITIES REFLECTED PROBABLY SIX PHUC YEN BASED MIG-21'S CONDUCTING AN INTER-AIRFIELD FLIGHT TO YUNNANI, CHINA, VIA A STOP-OVER AT MENGZU. ASF REFLECTED THE MIG-21'S IN TWO FLIGHTS, ONE OFFOUR AND ONE OF TWO AIRCRAFT, FLYING APPROXIMATELY FIVEMINUTES APART. THEY WERE INITIALLY REFLECTED IN THE PHUC YEN AREA AT #3#6Z HEADING NORTHWEST TO MENGZU WHERE THEY WERE REFLECTED ENTERING THE LANDING PATTERN AT #335Z. APPROXIMATELY FOUR HOURS LATER, AT #752Z, THESE MIG-21'S WERE REFLECTED TAKING-OFF FROM MENGZU AND HEADING TO YUNNAN, WHERE FLIGHT SERVICE FACILITIES INDICATED THEY PROBABLY LANDED AT #825Z. LATER ON THIS DATE, TWO ADDITIONAL POSSIBLE MIG-21'S WERE REFLECTED DEPLOYING FROM PHUC YEN TO MENGZU, CHINA. THIS FLIGHT WAS NOTED TAKING OFF FROM PHUC YEN AT 2337Z, AND FOLLOWING A FLIGHT ROUTE IDENTICAL TO THAT OF THE EARLIER DEPLOYMENT. THESE AIRCRAFT WERE LAST NOTED ENTERING THE LANDING PATTERN AT MENGZU AT 19#005Z. IT IS BELIEVED THESE MIGS CONTINUED ON TO YUNNANI LATER ON 19 OCT. ASSUMING THE SECOND GROUP OF MIGS CONTINUED ON TO YUNNANI, THE TOTAL NUMBER OF DRV MIGS NOW AT YUNNANI, CHINA IS RAISED TO 63, INCLUDING AT LEAST 18, POSSIBLY 20, MIG-21'S. B. KORCOM ACTIVITY. ACTIVITY CONSISTED OF A DEFENSIVE PATROL IN REACTION TO HOSTILE AIRCRAFT AND UNIDENTIFIED FLIGHT ACTIVITY, BOTH DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS. BETWEEN #9#6Z AND #934Z ON 18 OCTOBER, FOUR KORCOM-PILOTED MIG-17'S PERFORMED A DEFENSIVE PATROL IN REACTION TO THE USAF P.M. STRIKES AGAINST THE DAI LOI RR BRIDGE, WHICH RESULTED IN ONE MIG-17 BEING SHOT DOWN BY WILDCAT FOUR (ONE F-105) AS HE WAS COMING OFF OF HIS TARGET RUN. THE REMAINING THREE MIG-17'S RECOVERED AT PHUC YEN. C. SOVIET ACTIVITY. SOVIET

FLIGHT ACTIVITY CONSISTED OF TEST/CHECK-OUTFLIGHTS AND UNIDENTIFIED FLIGHT ACTIVITY DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS. D. AOB THIS AIRFIELD IS CURRENTLY CREDITED WITH 10 MIG-17 AND 5 MIG-21 AIRCRAFT. 2. HANOI/GIA LAM. A TOTAL OF 94 MIG SORTIES WERE PREFLIGHTED FROM THIS AIRFIELD, AND AT LEAST 33 WERE FLOWN. THIS SHOWS A SLIGHT DECREASE FROM THE 46 THAT WERE FLOWN THE PREVIOUS WEEK. A. ALL SORTIES FLOWN FROM THIS FIELD WERE BY VIETNA-MESE PILOTS. ACTIVITY CONSISTED OF DEFENSIVE PATROLS IN REACTION TO HOSTILE AIRCRAFT, AIR ATTACK PRACTICE AND UN-IDENTIFIED FLIGHT ACTIVITY, ALL DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS. B. SINCE THE USAF STRIKE ON 12 OCTOBER, THERE HAVE BEEN NO REFLECTIONS OF TACTICAL ACTIVITY IN/OUT OF THIS AFLD. THIS AFLD IS PRESENTLY CREDITED WITH NO OPERATIONAL MIG ACFT. LAUNCHES WERE UNSUCCESSFUL BECAUSE OF TARGET MANEUVERS. SAM BN V1458, 17:54:8.-53 59 503 236TH RGT, WAS NOTED IN SINGLE LAUNCH ACTIVITY AT 0052 AND AGAIN AT 0112Z. BOTH LAUNCHES WERE UNSUCCESSFUL. AN UNIDENTIFIED BN, SUBORDINATE TO THE 236TH RGT, WAS NOTED REFERENCING A DOUBLE LAUNCH WHICH PROBABLY OCCURRED AT 0116Z. NO RESULTS WERE REPORTED. SAM BN V1458, SUBORDINATE TO THE 236TH RGT, WAS INTERCEPTED LATER IN THE DAY REPORTING A SYNOPSIS OF THE BN'S FIRING ACTIVITIES DURING THE AM STRIKES. A STUDY OF THE REPORTED LAUNCH AND DETONATION POINTS INDICATES THAT AS MANY AS TEN MISSILES WERE FIRED AT RANGES BETWEEN 7-21NMS. 900 NNNN
