(3/0 [] R38-69) MILITARY REGION 5 OPERATION "SOCIALIST PEOPLE'S PARTY" NORTH OF POY (13-50N 107-02E, YA 1828), RATANAKIRI MSD, UNCOVERED THREE REBEL CAMPS BETWEEN 9 AND 11 FEBRUARY. EARLIER MESSAGES REPORTED SKIRMISHES NEAR BONHOK (13-48N 107-06E, YA 2726). FROM 14 TO 16 FEBRUARY REBELS HARASSED POSTS IN SOUTHERN RATANAKIRI. THE 11TH INFANTRY BATTALION IS TO CARRY OUT A SEARCH AND SWEEP OPERATION IN THAT AREA, AND MORTARS AND RIFLES WERE REQUESTED "WITHOUT DELAY" FOR THE STATE PLANTATION AT LABANSIEK (13-43N 106-57E, YA 1519). PRINCE SIHANOUK POSSIBLY WILL VISIT RATANAKIRI IN MARCH. ON 11 FEBRUARY, IN STUNG TRENG MSD, CAMBODIAN FORCES AMBUSHED 50 LAOTIANS SUPPOSEDLY PART OF A GROUP OF 70 INFILTRATORS, AT KOMPONG AMPIL (14-01N 105-47E, WA 8749). TWO DAYS LATER, A CAMBODIAN MESSAGE REQUESTED A LIST OF FOREIGN NATIONALS LOCATED IN SEVERAL DISTRICTS IN STUNG TRENG. ELSEWHERE IN THE MSD, REBELS FIRED ON BOATS CARRYING CAMBODIAN MILITARY ELEMENTS NEAR SIEM PANG (14-07N 106-23E, XA 5060) ON 7 AND 10 FEBRUARY. (3/0 [] R38-69 THROUGH R43-69) MILITARY REGION 6 AN UNIDENTIFIED L-19 AIRCRAFT FIRED ON CAMBODIAN TERRITORY NEAR THMAR PASA KRASHAM (12-02N 106-28E, XU 5831), KRATIE MSD, ON 14 FEBRUARY. ON 15 FEBRUARY REBELS ARMED WITH SUBMACHINEGUNS AND RIFLES REPORTEDLY HARASSED A MILITARY UNIT NEAR PEAM CHIMEAT POST (13-18N 107-09E, YV 3372), MONDOLKIRI MSD. (3/0 [] R42-69. R43-69)

ALLIED AIRCRAFT SHOT DOWN BY CAMBODIAN GROUND FIRE AN ALLIED L-20 AIRCRAFT, HIT BY CAMBODIAN GROUND-FIRE, REPORTEDLY CRASHED AT PRASAT (11-01N 106-10E, XT 2719), SVAY RIENG MILITARY SUBDIVISION (MSD) ON 12 FEBRUARY. ACCORDING TO THE CAMBODIANS, THE AMERICAN PILOT NAMED "OSSBON" WAS CAPTURED BY THEIR FORCES AND TAKEN TO SVAY RIENG (11-05N 105-48E, WT 8722) AND WAS BEING SENT FROM THERETO PHNOM PENH (11-33N 104-55E, VT 9177). THE THREE REMAINING MEMBERS OF THE CREW WERE TURNED OVER TO THE OPERATIONAL COMMAND POST OF MILITARY REGION 1 ON 14 FEBRUARY. AFTER THE INCIDENT, U.S. AIRCRAFT FLEW OVER AND FIRED ON THE SITE OF THE CRASH. THE OPERATIONAL COMMAND POST, MR 1, WITH REINFORCEMENT ELEMENTS, THE 25TH INFANTRY BATTALION, TWO AAA BATTERIES, A 105-MM BATTERY, AND AN M8 ARMORED CAR PLATOON WERE TO MOVE TO THE AREA OF THE CRASH. INITIAL ALERTS OF THE 56TH INFANTRY BATTALION AND THE AIR FORCE WERE SUBSEQUENTLY CANCELLED. COLLATERAL REPORTS THAT A U-1 RADIO RESEARCH AIRCRAFT WITH FOUR CREW MEMBERS WAS DOWNED BY GROUND-FIRE AT THE ABOVE LOCATION ON 12
