

~~SOUTHEAST ASIA SIGINT SUMMARY XXCC III. LAOS A. AIR DEFENSE ACTIVITY THE POSSIBLE DOWNING OF A B-26K AIRCRAFT WAS REPORTED IN A COMMUNIQUE OF 27 MARCH FROM TOAN (TOANF, AT THE 18TH AAA BATTALION). IT WAS DISCLOSED THAT THREE GUNS OF THE 3D COMPANY AT TA LE (17-11N 106-09E, XE2302) HAD EXPENDED 32 ROUNDS AT THE AIRCRAFT. THE AIRCRAFT WAS HIT AND BURST INTO FLAMES. THE AIRCRAFT WAS LAST SEEN GOING DOWN IN A SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION FROM THE 3D COMPANY'S POSITION.~~  
~~(SECRET SPOKE) B. LAOS-SOUTH VIETNAM BORDER ACTIVITY A REFERENCE TO "DECOY TROOPS" IN THE VICINITY OF HIGH POINT 1009 (BELIEVED TO BE AT XD 9202, 16-18N 106-47E) WAS DISCLOSED IN A 27 MARCH MESSAGE FROM NGHINH (NGHINH, NOT FURTHER IDENTIFIED) TO COMMANDER TAN (TAN, PREVIOUSLY ASSOCIATED WITH THE 3D REGIMENT). NGHINH REPORTED THAT A SEARCH DETACHMENT HAD STARTED ACROSS HIGH POINT 1009 ON THE MORNING OF 23 MARCH AND AT 0900G, HELICOPTERS ARRIVED AT 1009 AND THE SOUND OF INFANTRY WEAPONS-FIRE WAS HEARD. THE MESSAGE STATED THAT IT WAS NOT CLEAR WHETHER IT WAS FIRING FROM THE DETACHMENT OR ENEMY GROUND FORCES FIRING ON THE "DECOY TROOPS." A SECOND 27 MARCH REPORT, FROM AN UNIDENTIFIED PERSONALITY PROBABLY AT HIGH POINT 1232 (POSSIBLY AT 16-18N 106-45E XD8704,) TO COMMANDER TAN (TAN) REVEALED A CLASH WITH ALLIED FORCES. A SEARCH AND DESTROY TEAM, UPON HEARING GUN-FIRE IN THE DISTANCE, JOINED UP WITH THE MILITIA OF A XIN VILLAGE (POSSIBLY A TSIN, 16-18N 106-50E, XD 9702) AND ATTACKED THE ALLIED TROOPS, WHO WITHDREW TO AN UNNAMED MOUNTAIN. THERE WAS NO REPORT OF CASUALTIES ON EITHER SIDE. (2/G11/VCM/12622-69, 310250Z) ~~(SECRET SPOKE)~~ C. MILITARY SITUATION NORTHERN LAOS ROYAL LAOTIAN ARMY (RLA) COMMUNICATIONS REPORTED THAT THE PATHET LAO (PL) 761ST BATTALION WAS LOCATED ABOUT 30 KM NORTH OF SOP KAI (21-02N 102-26E, TJ 3429), IN SOUTHERN PHONG SALLY PROVINCE, MR 1 ON 4 APRIL. ALSO, THREE PL COMPANIES WERE REPORTEDLY DEPLOYED IN AN AREA 15-20 KM NORTH OF NAM BAC (20-38N 102-28E, TH 3584), LUANG PRABANG PROVINCE. TO THE EAST, RLA VOLUNTEER BATTALION (BV) 27 REPORTED HEAVY ENEMY PRES-SURE ON ITS POSITION ABOUT 18 KM NORTHWEST OF MUONG HIEM (LS- 48A, 20-05N 103-23E, HU 3022) AND REQUESTED AID. THE PREVIOUSLY REPORTED SWEEP INVOLVING RLA BV 24 IN SOUTHWESTERN XIENG KHOUANG PROVINCE, MR 2, HAS RESULTED IN THE CAPTURE OF BAN POUNG (19-16N 103-19E, UG 2331), BAN MAY (19-14N 103-16E, UG 1928), AND NAM SAB (19-10N 103-22E, UG 1927). TWO COMMUNIST ROAD AMBUSHES WERE REPORTED IN VIENTIANE PROVINCE, MR 5. ONE OCCURRED ON ROUTE 13, 30 KM NORTH OF VIENTIANE. THE OTHER, IN THE MUONG SOUM (18-30N 102-53E, TF 4676) AREA OF NORTHERN VIENTIANE ACTIVITY. SITUATION AT DONG HENE (16-42N 105-17E, WD 3146), MR 3, HAS "BECOME CRITICAL," ACCORDING TO AN RLA MESSAGE OF 5 APRIL. SAND BAGS AND AMMUNITION WERE REQUESTED FOR FORTIFICATION OF THE RLA CAMP THERE. PREVIOUS SIGINT HAS REPORTED THAT AT LEAST ONE COMMUNIST BATTALION WAS NORTHWEST OF THE TOWN AND THAT AN ATTACK WAS EXPECTED ON 12 APRIL. XXHH 900Z UUUUU

ZKZK PP RHI DE P 082000Z FM DIRNSA TO OSCAR/UNIFORM TANGO ZEM ~~TOP SECRET UMBRA~~ SECTION EIGHT XXMMENP08-TB08049 3/01 PR84-69 NATIONAL SECURITY AGENCY (SOUTHEAST ASIA) SIGINT SUMMARY XXCC ON 6 APRIL, THE NVA 4TH BATTALION, LOCATED IN THE WC 8476 (16-04N 105-47E) VICINITY OF SAVANNAKET PROVINCE, DIRECTED POSSIBLY ITS 12TH COMPANY TO REST ON 7 APRIL AND DRAW EXPERIENCE FROM ITS RECENT ACTIVITIES. CARE WAS TO BE TAKEN HOWEVER, TO MAINTAIN SECURITY AND GUARD AGAINST "DEADLY ENEMY AIRCRAFT." THE COMPANY WAS FURTHER ORDERED TO PREPARE AN UN- DISCLOSED PLAN AND SEND IT TO BATTALION THE FOLLOWING DAY. ON 7 APRIL THE COMPANY INFORMED THE BATTALION THAT IT HAD GONE TO COORDINATES WC 8364 (15-57N 105-47E), WC 8464 (15-57N 105-48E), WC 8564 (15-57N 105-49E), WC 8664 (15-57N 105-50E), WC 8764 (15-57N 105-51E), WC 8864 (15-57N 105-52E), WC 8665 (15-58N 105-50E), AND WC 8765 (15-58N 105-51E) FOR THE "PAST TWO MORNINGS." THE PRESENCE OF AN UNIDENTIFIED UNIT AT WC 833642 (15-57N 105-47E) AND THE PLACENAME DAN PHOU PHAY (15-58N 105-53E, WC 9165) WERE ALSO MENTIONED, THE LATTER IN AN UNCLEAR CONTEXT. THE BATTALION WAS ALSO INFORMED BY THIS COMPANY THAT IT WAS RESTING, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DIRECTIVE SENT ON 6 APRIL. COMMUNICATIONS OF 6 APRIL BETWEEN THE BATTALION AND ITS 9TH COMPANY DISCLOSED THAT THE COMPANY WAS TO PRACTICE "SAPPER TACTICS," SEARCH OUT AND DESTROY THE ENEMY'S BIVOUAC AREAS, AND STRIKE WHEN THE ENEMY WAS IN SMALL GROUPS. AN EARLIER MESSAGE, POSSIBLY FROM THE 12TH COMPANY, INFORMED THE BATTALION THAT 74 COMRADES OF THE NVA 5TH BATTALION HAD ARRIVED. (3/ PR79-69, 2X/ PLSM/T231-69, 080702Z) ~~SECRET SPOKE~~ IV. CAMBODIA MILITARY SITUATION MILITARY REGION I A VIET CONG CAMP REPORTEDLY IS LOCATED AT WT 1608 (10-56N 105-09E) SOUTH OF THE BENG YANG (10-56N 105-08E, WT 15-08) STREAM KANDAL MILITARY SUBDIVISION (MSD), THE AREA OF THE CAMBODIAN OPERATION PREVIOUSLY REPORTED. THE VC HOLD COMBAT INSTRUCTIONS AT NIGHT AND HAVE SET UP A PERIMETER AROUND THE CAMP. THE TROOPS REPORTEDLY ARE "SPREAD OUT" SOUTH OF THE RIVER. ON 6 APRIL, A U.S./ARVN AIRCRAFT ALLEGEDLY OVERFLEW AN AREA SOUTH OF KAAM SAMNAR KROM (10-58N 105-11E, WT 1908). ALSO IN KANDAL MSD, TWO VIETNAMESE FAMILIES, REPORTED ACCOMPLICES OF THE U.S./ARVN, CROSSED INTO SOUTH VIETNAM ON 4 APRIL. IN SOUTHWESTERN SVAY RIENG MSD, U.S./ARVN AIRCRAFT REPORTEDLY BOMBED AND STRAFED ALONG THE BORDER ON 7 APRIL. IN THE SAME MSD, AN ALLEGED U.S./ARVN AIRCRAFT WAS FIRED UPON BY CAMBODIANS DURING AN OVERFLIGHT IN THE VICINITY OF MESAR THNGAK (10-57N 106-06E, XT2311) ON 5 APRIL.


