SIGINT SUMMARY XXCC 6. MILITARY REGION 2 A NEW COMMUNICATIONS GROUP CONSISTING  
OF A CONTROL AUTHORITY (B4523) AND THREE UNIDENTIFIED, UNLOCATED SUBSCRIBERS  
(B4524, B4525, AND B4526), HAS BEEN ISOLATED IN MR 2. FIRST HEARD ON 9 JULY,  
THE CONTROL AUTHORITY WAS LOCATED IN SOUTH-WESTERN TAY NINH PROVINCE NEAR  
11-10N 105-59E (XT 078355) ON 12 JULY, BUT BY 17 JULY THE TERMINAL HAD MOVED  
ABOUT 46 KM WEST-SOUTHWEST TO THE CAMBODIA-KIEN TUONG PROVINCE BORDER AREA NEAR  
10-58N 105-36E (WT 671135). ON 21 JULY THE CONTROL AUTHORITY WAS LOCATED IN THE  
VICINITY OF HQ, MR 2, NEAR 10-55N 105-14E (WT 267067) AND APPROXIMATELY 41 KM  
WEST OF ITS 17 JULY POSITION. FRAGMENTARY DIRECTION FINDING RESULTS OF 14 AND  
19 AUGUST INDICATE THAT THE CONTROL OF THE GROUP MAY HAVE MOVED FARTHER SOUTH  
TOWARD THE SEVEN MOUNTAINS AREA OF CHAU DOC PROVINCE. IF THE 14 AND 19 AUGUST  
LOCATIONS ARE CONFIRMED, IT WOULD PLACE AT LEAST THE CONTROL OF THIS GROUP IN  
THE SEVEN MOUNTAINS AREA WHERE THE SUSPECTED HQ, VC 273RD REGT WAS BASED  
FOLLOWING ITS ARRIVAL FROM THE NORTH IN APRIL. ACCORDING TO COLLATERAL,  
ELEMENTS OF THE 273RD REGT HAVE SINCE MOVED INTO WEST-CENTRAL KIEN GIANG  
PROVINCE OF MR 3. ~~(SECRET SPOKE)~~ II. NORTH VIETNAM A. INFILTRATION/LOGISTICS  
ACTIVITY 1. THE LOCATION OF K-110 WAS DISCLOSED IN A 17 AUGUST REAR SERVICES  
DIRECTIVE. IT WAS REVEALED THAT CARGO WAS TO BE TRANSFERRED FROM HOANG MAI  
(19-16N 105-43E, WG 7631) TO K-110, TAM BONG (TAM BOONG, PROBABLE PLACENAME,  
UNLOCATED IN NGHIE AN PROVINCE). SINCE 14 AUGUST, A TOTAL OF 799 PERSONNEL HAVE  
BEEN OBSERVED MOVING NORTHWARD THROUGH BT 34.5 AREA OF OPERATIONS (POSSIBLE  
VICINITY OF MUONG NONG 16-22N 106-30E, XD 60101). OF THIS TOTAL THERE WERE 411  
SICK AND WOUNDED, 177 ON AS 75IGNMENT, 25 DESERTERS, 15 CIVIL ADMINISTRATORS,  
23 MISCELLANEOUS PERSONNEL AND 12 TRANSFEREES. 2. A 20 AUGUST MESSAGE BETWEEN  
FORWARD HQ, 559TH TRANSPORTATION GROUP AND BT 34 DISCLOSED THAT THERE WAS ONE  
"GUERRILLA PATROL" ACTIVE IN THE AREA OF HIGHPOINT 893 (PROBABLY AT 16-16N  
106-39E, XD 763004). IT WAS SUGGESTED THAT BT 34 SEARCH THE AREA AND SEND THE  
RESULTS BACK TO THE "GROUP." 3. FOUR SOUTHWARD-MOVING GROUPS HAVE BEEN NOTED  
THUS FAR IN AUGUST. (2/G11/VCN/T7218-69, 202203Z. 2/O/VCJ/R260-69, 202035Z)  
~~(SECRET SPOKE)~~ B. GROUND FORCES 1. HANOI COMMUNICATIONS ON 20 AUGUST, THE HIGH  
COMMAND OF THE ARMED FORCES OF NORTH VIETNAM (HCAFNV) MADE ARRANGEMENTS WITH  
THE DETACHED ELEMENT, 304TH DIVISION FOR "WATCH" COMMUNICATIONS SCHEDULES LATER  
IN THE DAY. NORMALLY, WATCH COMMUNICATIONS DO NOT OPERATE ON SCHEDULES, BUT IN  
THE PAST, WATCH SCHEDULING HAS OFTEN BEEN MADE FOR ENTITIES PREPARING TO MOVE.  
POSSIBLY RELATED TO THIS ACTIVITY WAS A NINE-PART, URGENT MESSAGE TRANSMITTED

BY HCAFNV TO THE DETACHED ELEMENT, 304TH DIVISION ON 19 AUGUST. MESSAGES BETWEEN HCAFNV AND THIS STATION HAVE USUALLY BEEN IN SINGLE-PARTS. ALSO, LATER IN THE DAY, HCAFNV TRANSMITTED A SINGLE-PART, MOST URGENT (HIGHEST PRECEDENCE) MESSAGE TO BOTH THE DETACHED ELEMENT, 304TH DIVISION AND TO THE HQ, 304TH DIVISION, AN UNCOMMON OCCURRENCE. 2. MILITARY REGION 3 LEFT BANK ON 19 AUGUST, HQ, MILITARY REGION 3 LEFT BANK WAS OBSERVED IN AN UNSUCCESSFUL ATTEMPT TO COMMUNICATE WITH THE HQ, NVA 330TH INFANTRY DIVISION. THIS IS THE FIRST NOTED ATTEMPT TO COMMUNICATE BETWEEN THESE ENTITIES SINCE THE SUCCESSFUL CONTACT ON 29 JULY. COMMUNICATIONS BETWEEN THE DIVISION HEADQUARTERS AND ITS TWO UNIDENTIFIED-REGIMENTAL ECHELON SUBORDINATES (M5476 AND M3077) CONTINUE UNOBSERVED SINCE 27 JUNE AND 24 MAY, RESPECTIVELY. (3/0/ [ ] R179-6) ~~SECRET SPOKE~~ C. AIR/AIR DEFENSE FORCES AAA COMMUNICATIONS REFLECT SHOOTDOWN OF U.S. AIRCRAFT OVER QUANG BINH PROVINCE. DURING THE LATE MORNING HOURS OF 19 AUGUST, AAA- ASSOCIATED COMMUNICATIONS CONTAINED REFERENCES TO THE SHOOTDOWN OF A U.S. AIRCRAFT OVER QUANG BINH PROVINCE ON THAT DATE. LATER IN THE DAY THERE WAS REFERENCE MADE TO THE "PILOT" BEING FOUND DEAD. NO OTHER DETAILS WERE REVEALED. ACCORDING TO OPERATIONAL DATA, A U.S. MARINE F4B WAS MISSING OVER QUANG BINH PROVINCE AS OF 0425Z ON 19 AUGUST. (2/GI17VCM/T7181-69, 191531Z. T7183-69, 191656Z.
