TEXT XXCC I. EASTERN/CENTRAL DMZ: D A. GROUP 31: AN UNIDENTIFIED ELEMENT (M82532 OF GROUP 31 MENTIONED THAT A MEETING WITH FRIENDS WAS TAKING PLACE AND REPORTED THAT SIX OR SEVEN COMRADES WOULD BRING RICE TO THE SIX POSITIONS AT THE ROADS. IT ALSO ORDERED AS RELAY STATION ASSOCIATED WITH COMPANY 17, GROUP 31 TO GO TO POSITIONS NEAR THE ROAD ABOUT 1 OR 2 JUCE. (2/G11/VCM/T3050-70) B. 27B REGIMENT: ON 31 MAY THE HQ, 27 REGIMENT WAS LOCATED WITHIN 1600 METERS OF YD 11-129 (16-49N 106-58E), ABOUT THREE KM WEST OF C-3 COMBAZ BASE (YD 143 614 16-49N 107-00E). THIS REPRESENTS AN APPROXIMATE NINE KM RELLOCATION IN AN EAST-SOUTH-EASTERLY DIRECTION FROM THE HEADQUARTERS' 26 MAY LOCATION OF WITHIN 1800 METERS OF SYD 032 658 (16-51N 106-54E). COMMUNICATIONS ACTIVITY SERVING UNIDENTIFIED ELEMENTS OF THE REGIMENT'S 3RD BATTALION CENTERED AROUND ACTIVITIES IN THE AREAS OF DOI DA (YD 02 60, 16-48N 106-53E) AND DOI XANH (YD 038 619, 16-49N 106-54E). ALSO, REFERENCE WAS MADE TO THE SOLVING OF PROBLEMS INVOLVING THE REGIMENT'S 1ST AND 2ND BATTALIONS. IT WAS REPORTED ON 30 MAY THAT ONE COMPANY OF ALLIES AT 166 (YD 070 598, 16-48N 106-56E) WAS MOVING TOWARD THE HIGH POINT AT DOI XANH. LATER IT WAS STATED THAT KHA AND TIEM (BOTH UNIDENTIFIED PERSONALITIES) WERE RETURNING TO DOI DA AND DOI XANH. WEAPONS WERE REQUESTED TO BE SENT TO THEM, POSSIBLY TO STRIKE AN ALLIED COMPANY SOUTHEAST OF DOI XACH. OTHER MESSAGE ACTIVITY ALSO REFERENCED PROPOSED ATTACKS ON DOI DA AND DOI XACH, AS WELL AS ON 99 (YD 062 666, 16-51N 106-55E). CONCERNING THE 1ST AND 2ND BATTALIONS, IT WAS QUERIED AS TO WHETHER THE PROBLEM OF WHERE THE 2ND BATTALION WAS GOING HAD BEEN SOLVED, AS WELL AS THE SOLVING OF AN UNSPECIFIED POLICY FOR THE 1ST BATTALION. (TACREP NR 925-70 PASEP G11/H 310917Z; 2/G11/VCM/T3047-70, T3048-70, T3053-70, T3044-70, T3056-70, T3043-70/SCHANGE ONE) C. 84TH ARTILLERY REGIMENT: COMMUNICATIONS ACTIVITY ON 30 MAY BETWEEN UNIDENTIFIED ELEMENTS OF THE 84TH ARTILLERY REGIMENT REVEALED THAT ALLIED AIR STRIKES HAD STRUCK AT BOTH AN UNSPECIFIED ELEMENT'S POSITION AND AT UNLOCATED POSITION Q. IT WAS REPORTED THAT AN UNSPECIFIED UNIT WAS UNABLE TO ENGAGE IN TACTICAL ACTIVITIES AS A RESULT OF ITS BEING VERY EXPOSED, PROBABLY TO THE AIR STRIKES. COLLATERAL HOLDS THAT ALLIED AIR STRIKES TOOK PLACE ON 30 MAY IN THE GENERAL VICINITY OF THE 1ST AND 2ND BATTALIONS OF THE 84TH ARTILLERY REGIMENT. THE 1ST BATTALION WAS LOCATED ON 24IMAY WITHIN 750 METERS OF YD 006 623 (16-49N 106-52E), APPROXIMATELY FOUR KM NORTH OF FSB FULLER (YD 019 592, 16-48N 106-53E), AND THE 2ND BATTALION WAS LOCATED ON 26 MAY WITHIN 300 METERS OF XD 984 635 (16-50N 106-51E), SOME SEVEN KM NORTH OF FSB FULLER. IT WAS ALSO REPORTED THAT A UNIT WAS TO FIRE FIVE OR SIX UNSPECIFIED ROUNDS WITH NO TARGET BEING DESIGNATED. (2/G11/VCMT3046-70, 3045-70) II. WESTERN QUANG TRI PROVINCE: AN UNIDENTIFIED ELEMENT OF THE NVA 314TH DIVISION REPORTED ON 29 MAY THAT THE ALLIES HAD LANDED TROOPS FOUR TIMES IN AN UNSPECIFIED AREA AND THAT A GROUP WAS CONDUCTING RECONNAISSANCE EAST OF COC GIANG (XD 91 34, 16-34N 106-47E). IT FURTHER NOTED THAT THE ALLIES HAD THE ABILITY TO FINISH LOADING. IN 30 MAY MESSAGE ACTIVITY, AN UNIDENTIFIED DIVISIONAL ELEMENT REPORTED THAT THE ALLIES WERE CAPABLE OF LANDING TROOPS ON 30 AND 31 MAY AT CO TIEN (YD 07 32, 16-33N 106-56E), 372 (YD 020 357, 16-35N 106-53E), DONG CAI (YD 013 331, 16-33N 106-53E), 380 (XD 973 358, 16-35N 106-50E), DA BAN (XD 956 332, 16-33N 106-50E) 640 (XD +92 295, 16-31F 106-52E), AND THE UNLOCATED HOC COC RIVER. AN INSPECTION OF THE TACTICAL TRENCHES WAS REQUESTED AS WELL AS VLOSE RECONNAISSANCE FROM THE OBSERVATION STATION. DESTRUCTION BY ALLIED AIR STRIKES WAS RECOUNTED BY AN UNIDENTIFIED DIVISIONAL ELEMENT ON 30 MAY. THE ELEMENT NOTED THAT MUCH OF ITS ACTIVITY HAD BEEN DESTROYED IN AN AREA NORTHWEST OF AN UNSPECIFIED VILLAGE BY HELICOPTERS FIRING BETWEEN 1100G AND 1200G. FROM 1300G TO 0400G AN AREA MORE THAN

500 METERS NORTHWEST OF DONG RIANG TUAN (VICINITY OF XD 93 37, 16-36N 106-49E) AND 604 (XD 937 367, 16-36N 106-49E) WAS REPORTEDLY STRUCK WITH BOMBS. IN THE AFTERNOON, AIR RECONNAISSANCE WAS NOTED BEING CONDUCTED OVER THIS SAME GENERAL AREA. (2/G11/VCM/T3036-70, T3039-70, T3055-70) III. MILITARY REGION TRI-THIEN-HUE (MR TTH) 324B DIVISION A. 29TH REGIMENT RETROSPECTIVE ANALYSIS CONCERNING THE REPORTED 30 MAY REDEPLOYMENT OF THE HQ, 29TH REGIMENT TO WITHIN 1800 METERS OF YC 276 982 (16-14N 107-07E), SOME 11 KM WEST OF A LUOI, INDICATES THAT THIS MOE COULD HAVE OCCURRED ON OR ABOUT 16 MAY. A 16 MAY LOCATION WITHIN 1200 METERS OF YC 262 987 (16-14N 107-06E) AND ANOTHER 30 MAY LOCATION WITHIN 350 METERS OF YC 260 995 (16-15N 107-06Z) TEND TO CONFIRM THAT THE RELOCATION INTO LAOS DID TAKE PLACE AS EARLY AS 16 MAY. PREVIOUSLY, THE HEADQUARTERS WAS LOCATED ON 9 MAY WITHIN 1500 METERS OF YD 411 057 (16-19N 107-15E) IN THE MOVE REPRESENTS A RELOCATION OF SOME 15 KM IN A SOUTHWESTERLY DIRECTION. SPARSE COMMUNICATION ACTIVITY BETWEEN UNIDENTIFIED ELEMENTS OF THE 29TH REGIMENT INDICATED THAT FOOD FOR AN UNIDENTIFIED UNIT WAS SCARCE, AND THAT HARASSMENT OF THE ALLIES WAS BEING CARRIED ON WITH ONLY A SMALL NUMBER OF TROOPS. (2/G11/VCM/T3054-70) B. 803RD REGIMENT IN A CORUQT 30 MAY MESSAGE, AN UNIDENTIFIED ELEMENT OF THE 803RD REGIMENT, 324B DIVISION, MENTIONED STRIKES POSSIBLY DIRECTED AT ALLIED FORCES POSITIONED AT 959 (YD 441 120, 16-23N 107-16E) AND 700 (YD 468 110, 16-22N 107-17E, FSB KATHRYN). (YSM 605 NR T186-70) C. 812TH REGIMENT THE REGIMENTAL HEADQUARTERS AND THE HQ, 6TH BATTALION OF THE 812TH REGIMENT WAS LOCATED WITHIN 1000 METERS OF YD 249 255 (16-29N 107-05E), SOME EIGHT KM WEST OF FSB O'REILLY (YD 324 258, 16-29N 107-10E). THIS REPRESENTS A MOVE OF APPROXIMATELY TEN KM IN A SOUTH-SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION FROM THIS ENTITY'S 25 MAY LOCATION WITHIN 700 METERS OF YD 290 344 (16-34N 107-08E). THE HQ, 6TH BATTALION 812TH REGIMENT, WAS LOCATED SOME 15 KM SOUTHWEST OF FSB TUN TAVERN (YD 059328, 16-33N 106-55E) WITHIN 500 METERS OF XD 946 243 (16-29N 106-49E). THIS REPRESENTS A RELOCATION OF SOME 14 KM IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION FROM ITS 23 MAY POSITION WITHIN 700 METERS OF YD 074 211 (16-27N 106-56E).
