FROM B-1 ((9)) 10 MEN, 1 STRETCHER CASE, 1 WOUNDED, AND 2 SICK. FROM B-2 ((10)) 6 MEN 5 WOUNDED, AND 1 SICK. FROM B-3 ((11)) 2 MEN, BOTH WOUNDED. FROM B-4 ((12)) 4 MEN, 1 STRETCHER CASE. FROM REAR SERVICES 4 MEN, 1 WOUNDED, 3 ARE ON A MISSION FROM BINH TRAM 42 ((13)), TO GO ON A MISSION TO BATTLE AREA C((14)). THERE ARE 10 MEN ON A MISSION. 153 MEN REMAIN, 12 STRETCHER CASES, 4-PARALYZED, 213 SICK AND WOUNDED (SIC), Q14 DESERTERS, 7 AMERICANS PRISONERS AND 3 ARVN PRISONERS. WOUNDED ON STRETCHERS REMAINING T-31-4 T-32 -12, T-35 ((4)) /-19, T33 - 23. ((CONCERNIGN)) THE ENEMY SITUATION FOR THE NIGHT OF THE 4TH AND 5TH OF JULY, THE ENEMY CAUSED DESTRUCTION IN THE AREA OF BAN KENG LA THONG ((15)) NEAR T-33 AREA. ON THE 4TH AND 5TH OF JULY T-33 ORGANIZED TWO SEARCH TEAMS FOR BOTH SIDES ((XGRG)) PRESENTLY AT THE BANK NORTH OF THE RIVER THERE ARE FOOT PRINTS OF RAIDERS. COLLECTED WERE 2 PAIR OF UNDERWEAR, ONE PAIR OF SOCKS, AND TWO CARTONS OF MENTHOL CIGARETTES. FOR CONTINUING THE SEARCH IT WAS REALIZED THAT THERE WAS NOTHING MORE ((IN THE AREA)).
