III. NORTH VIENTAM A. NVA 271ST INDEPENDENT REGIMENT, COMMUNICATIONS ON 28
 FEBRUARY BETWEEN UNIDENTIFIED ELEMENTS OF THE 271ST INDEPENDENT REGIMENT
 REVEALED THAT REGIMENTAL ELEMENTS WERE TO OBSERVE AN INCREASED STATE OF
 VIGILANCE IN ORDER TO CRUSH THE \$ENEMY\$. IT WAS NOTED THAT BATTALION 7 WAS TO
 SEND PERSONNEL UP TO UNLOCATED THAN VU IN ORDER TO TELL LONG AND HAN
 (UNIDENTIFIED PERSONALITIES) TO RETURN TO SEE COMRADE OI (UNIDENTIFIED
 PERSONALITIES) TO RETURN TO SEE COMRADE OI (UNIDENTIFIED PERSONALITY),
 REPORTEDLY THE STAFF ASSISTANT FOR COMBAT TRAINING OF REGIMENT. FINALLY, AN
 UNSPECIFIED INDIVIDUAL WAS TO BE PRESENT AT REGIMENT IN ORDER TO RECEIVE THE
 COMBAT MISSION, AND THAT THIS SAME INDIVIDUAL WAS TO PROCEED TO COMPANY 8'S
 (SUBORDINATION UNKNOWN, POSSIBLY 5TH BATTALION) POSITION AT UNLOCATED NGHIEU
 LAM. (2/FI/VCM/T1680-71, T1684-71, AND T1686-71) B. QUANG BINH PROVINCIAL UNIT
 (QBPU), EXPLOITABLE MESSAGE ACTIVITY ON 27 AND 28 FEBRUARY BETWEEN ELEMENTS OF
 THE QUANG BINH PROVINCIAL UNIT CONTINUE TO EXPRESS CONCERN OVER ALLIED MOVEMENTS
 AND STRENGTH AND POSSIBLE DEFENSIVE MEASURES TO BE EMPLOYED BY NVA ENTITIES
 IN THE EVENT OF ATTACK. IN ONE MESSAGE, IT WAS REVEALED THAT A POSSIBLE COMMAND
 POST, A COMMAND GROUP 4 AND COMPANY 9 (SUBORDINATION UNKNOWN) HAD FINISHED
 UNSPECIFIED PREPARATIONS. SECTIONS THAT WERE POSSIBLY PROTECTED BY THESE
 PREPARATIONS INCLUDE, NGU THUY (UNLOCATED), THAI THUY (UNLOCATED), SEN THUY (YD
 230 862, 17-03N 107-04E), ROUTES 16 (AKA ROUTE 1032B) 4 AND THACH BAN (YD 248
 873, 17-03N 107-04E /OR / YD 240 862, 17-03, 107-04E). THE FORTIFICATIONS WERE
 REPORTED AS HAVING BEEN CAMOUFLAGED WELL. ADDITIONALLY, IT WAS DISCLOSED THAT
 WHEN AN UNSPECIFIED BATTALION TRANSFERS F1 AND F2 (POSSIBLY FIRING
 EMPLACEMENTS), AN UNDISCLOSED ELEMENT WAS TO SEND FOUR PRIME MOVERS TO
 TRANSPORT AMMUNITION, 12.7MM HEAVY MACHINE GUNS AND 400 LITERS OF AN UNDETER-
 MINED SUBSTANCE. ANOTHER MESSAGE REPORTED THAT THERE WAS NO REASON TO WORRY IF
 THE \$ENEMY\$ HAD THE SAME STRENGTH AS BEFORE. ALSO, AN UNIDENTIFIED COMPANY WAS
 REPORTED TO BE EQUIPPED WITH 14MM WEAPONS (PROBABLY 14.7M HEAVY MACHINE GUNS).
 FINALLY, IT WAS REVEALED THAT THE LE THUY DISTRICT UNIT (ADMINISTRATIVE
 DISTRICT OF QUANG BINH PROVINCE) HAD ORGANIZED ITS FORCES TO ACT IN
 SELF-DEFENSE OF THE LE NINH AGRICULTURAL SITES AND QUICKLY MOBILIZED TO
 COORDINATE WITH THE UNIT IN MAKING A SURPRISE STRIKE AT THE ENEMY\$. IT WAS ALSO
 ADDED THAT ATTENTION WAS TO BE PAID TO THE \$ENEMY\$ BECAUSE THEY WERE STRONGLY
 EQUIPPED. LONG TERM COMBAT OPERATIONS WERE ALSO MENTIONED IN UNDETERMINED

CONTEXT. (2/F1/VCM/T1679-71; T1683-71; T1685-71) C. CIVIL, CIVIL COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE VINH LINH SPECIAL DISTRICT ON 28 FEBRUARY REVEALED THAT ONE AIRCRAFT AND ONE ENEMY SHIP HAD BEEN DESTROYED DURING THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY. AN UNSPECIFIED ENEMY SHIP WAS REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN SUNK BY A UNIT 32 (NOT FURTHER IDENTIFIED) AND SUBSEQUENTLY THE SURVIVORS HAD CLIMBED UP ONTO BOUYS TO FLEE AND WERE IMMEDIATELY ANNIHILATED. THE RESULTS WERE SIX KILLED. THE GUERRILLA FORCES AND THE PEOPLE OF HUONG LAO (UNLOCATED) WERE REPORTED TO HAVE SHOT AT A GROUP OF PLANES THAT WERE ATTACKING THE VILLAGE, WITH ONE ARMED HELICOPTER SHOT DOWN AS A RESULT. ALSO OF NOTE, WAS A REPORT THAT ENEMY PLANES HAD STRUCK THE VILLAGE OF HUONG LAP WITH A CHEMICAL POISON. THE RESULTS OF THIS ATTACK WERE NOT DISCLOSED. (2X/F1/VCM/T1641-71) D. UNIDENTIFIED NVA, MESSAGE ACTIVITY ON 28 FEBRUARY BETWEEN UNIDENTIFIED NVA ELEMENTS REVEALED THAT THE MILITARY REGION WAS TO ASSUME ALERT LEVEL ONE. REPORTEDLY ALL UNITS WERE TO PREPARE FOR BATTLE AND BE ATTENTIVE IN CAMOUFLAGING ALL POSITIONS. IT WAS NOTED THAT REPORTS FROM H5 AND H3 (BOTH UNIDENTIFIED DESIGNATORS) POUBLY INDICATED HAT ALL UNITS WERE TO PREPARE TO ACT WITH INITIATIVE WHEN STRIKING THE ENEMYS. IT WAS REPORTED THAT REGIMENTAL ELEMENTS (64TH) WERE AT KM 106 (ON ROUTE 1032B, XD 525 415, 16-38N 106-24E) AS WELL AS COMPANY 7 OF BATTALION 2 (PROBABLY SUBORDINATE TO THE 36TH REGIMENT). IT WAS ALSO DISCLOSED THAT REGIMENT 36 WOULD DIRECT UNSPECIFIED OPERATIONS AS USUAL. IN POSSIBLY RELATED ACTIVITY, THE ARRIVAL OF CADRE OF 83 (UNIDENTIFIED DESIGNATOR) WAS DISCLOSED, AND IT WAS REPORTED THAT THESE CADRE, SIX IN NUMBER, WERE BEING LED BACK TO A REGIMENTAL COMMAND POST (PROBABLY THAT OF THE 64TH REGIMENT). IN TACTICAL ACTIVITY, IT WAS REPORTED THAT ONE NVA COMPANY WAS BLOCKING AT KM 109 (ON ROUTE 1032B; XD 526 395, 16-37N 106-24E), POSSIBLY EMPLOYING 82MM MMRMQT WAS FURTHER STATED THAT AN ENEMY MOLESHEADQUARTERS WOULD NOT BE ALLOWED TO ESCAPE. A RECONNAISSANCE REPORT STATED THAT FROM DOI GIANG (UNLOCATED), AN NVA ELEMENT HUF BERVED BURNING TO THE EAST AND WEST OF QHE CACHE AT Q-3 /"533 455, 16-41N FINALLY, IN A HIGHLY CORRUPT MESSAGE LATE ON 28 FEBRUARY, IT WAS REPORTED THAT AN UNSPECIFIED 704?-?)6 ;;- , HEADQUARTEKS WAS SURROUNDED.
