ENGLISH TO CONTACT THE PILOT BY SECRET MEANS IN AREAS 1 AND 2. AS A RESULT, DT 33 REPORTEDLY HAD SENT OUT THREE SEARCH TEAMS TOWARD THE K8 ROCK FIELD IN ORDER TO FORM AN AMBUSH. THE SEARCH TEAMS WERE TO CONTINUE IN THE PRE-PLANNED DIRECTIONS. K8 WAS ALSO WARNED TO BE CAREFUL OF ENEMY STRAFINGS. IN A LATER MESSAGE ON THE SAME DAY, PROBABLY DT 33 REVEALED THAT THE OV-10 PILOT WAS STILL IN THE AREA. (2/E1/VCJOT3570-71, 221223Z) 2. SINCE THE BEGINNING OF OPERATION LAM SON-720, REFERENCES TO A UNIT 643 HAVE BEEN NOTED IN COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE DT 42 AREA. SIGINT OF 21 MAY HAS NOW IDENTIFIED THIS UNIT AS THE 6430 REGIMENT. ON THAT DAY THE 37TH ENGINEER BATTALION INSTRUCTED PROBABLY ONE OF ITS COMPANIES TO GO BACK TO THE 6430 REGIMENT. A COMPANY 643 WAS OBSERVED IN THE DT 42 AREA IN EARLY 1968. AT THAT TIME, IT AND SEVERAL OTHER UNITS WERE ENGAGED IN THE CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR OF ROUTE 547, FROM A SHAU TO HENE. IT NOW APPEARS THAT THIS UNIT HAS BEEN UPGRADED TO REGIMENTAL ECHELON.
