(YD 103N, 16-20N 107-11E). ALSO, THERE WERE THREE ARVN BRIGADES--THE 258TH, THE  
254TH AND THE 369TH-- IN THE AREA OF LONG THO, WHICH WENT INTO CAP BI (PROBABLY  
AP CO BI, YD 6025, 16-30N 107-26E) AND KHOC CA BO (PROBABLY COC A BO, YD 4018,  
16-26N 107-51E). THE PROBABLE 7TH COMMO-LIAISON BATTALION OF BT 14, ON 7 MAY,  
NOTIFIED ITS SUBORDINATE COMMO-LIAISON STATIONS TO PREPARE TO RECEIVE A PILOT  
PRISONER WHO WAS BEING ESCORTED NORTHWARD BY TWO INFANTRY PERSONNEL OF BT 34.  
THE BATTALION ALSO MADE REFERENCE TO THE \$INTELLIGENCE OF THE UNITED  
STATES\$--POSSIBLY INDICATING THAT THE PRISONER IS THE \$INTELLIGENCE-TYPE\$  
PERSONNEL EARLIER REPORTED CAPTURED. (2/00/VCJ/R238-71, 072130Z AND  
2/00/VCJ/R239-71, 082130Z) ~~(SECRET SPOKE)~~ V. NORTH VIETNAM A. GROUND FORCES  
MILITARY REGION 4 THE FORWARD ELEMENT (B6242), HQ, NVA 320TH DIVISION, MAY HAVE  
RETURNED TO NORTH VIETNAM TO JOIN ITS PARENT UNIT. PRELIMINARY INDICATIONS THAT  
THE FORWARD ELEMENT MIGHT REDEPLOY NORTHWARD WERE NOTED IN EARLY MARCH WHEN THE  
FORWARD ELEMENT ESTABLISHED COMMUNICATIONS WITH HQ, MR 4. NO COMMUNICATIONS  
FROM THE FORWARD ELEMENT HAVE BEEN OBSERVED SINCE 29 APRIL. THE FORWARD ELEMENT  
WAS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHERN QUANG BINH PROVINCE-LAOS BORDER AREA ON 24 APRIL,  
WITHIN 25 NAUTICAL MILES OF XE #813 (17-18N 106-01E). AN ELEMENT OF THE NVA  
164TH ARTILLERY REGIMENT REPORTED ON 8 MAY THAT ALLIED HELICOPTER CARRIES AND  
DESTROYERS WERE OPERATING 135 KM OFF THE COAST, PROBABLY OFF QUANG BINH  
PROVINCE. THIS REPORTING UNIT FURTHER PROVIDED AN NVA UNIT STRENGTH REPORT  
WHICH DISCLOSED THAT THE \$TOTAL STRENGTH IS 215 MEN, OF WHICH 182 ARE ON HAND.\$  
THE REMAINING 33 MEN OF THE UNIT WERE REPORTEDLY ON VARIOUS OPERATIONAL AND
