AND 550 RIELS (APPROXIMATELY @10 U.S.) IN MAY, NOW REPORTEDLY
COSTS 1,100 RIELS (APPROXIMATELY @20 U.S.). (ACCORDING TO
[REDACTED] AN OFFICIALLY ORDERED REDUCTION IN PRICES HAS
BEEN FRUITLESS, AND THE LACK OF COMMENSURATE INCREASES IN
PAY SCALES FOR GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES AND THE EMPLOYEES OF
VARIOUS COMPANIES HAS RESULTED IN WIDESPREAD HARDSHIP. CAMBODIAN
COMMUNICATIONS OF 22 JUNE DISCLOSED THE PRESENCE OF 600
ENEMY, WITH SIX 82-MM MORTARS AND FIVE 75-MM RECOILLESS CANNONS,
IN AN AREA APPROXIMATELY 10 KM EAST OF ROMEAS. COMBAT ACTIVITY

EXPRESSED CONCERN ABOUT RECENT =ENEMY= AIR AND GROUND OPERATIONS NEAR THE JUNCTION OF ROUTES 4 AND 5. IN OTHER DEVELOPMENTS, AN UNIDENTIFIED SUBORDINATE OF THE NVA 316TH DIVISION HAS BEEN TENTATIVELY IDENTIFIED AS THE DETACHED ELEMENT OF THE DIVISION HEADQUARTERS AND THE HQ, NVA 866TH INDEPENDENT REGIMENT RELOCATED IN PROXIMITY TO BAN HON. IN THE PANHANDLE, THE RLA REPORTS THAT PRO-GOVERNMENT GUERRILLA FORCES OPERATING ON THE BOLOVENS PLATEAU ARE ENCOUNTERING COMMUNIST RESISTANCE. A PREVIOUSLY UNIDENTIFIED SUBORDINATE OF THE NVA 565TH GROUP HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED AS THE POSSIBLE NVA ADVISORY MISSION TO THE PATHET LAO HQ, BOLOVENS PROVINCE. (SECRET SPOKE)

1. NORTHERN LAOS NORTH OF THE PLAINE DES JARRES, COMMUNIST UNITS BOMBARDED THE BOUAM LONG AIRFIELD WITH 122-MM ROCKETS ON 28 JUNE, ACCORDING TO RLA COMMUNICATIONS. TWO CIVILIANS WERE KILLED AND THREE RLA SOLDIERS WERE WOUNDED. DURING THE EARLY MORNING OF 29 JUNE AN UNKNOWN NUMBER OF ENEMY LAUNCHED ATTACKS ON TWO RLA POSITIONS 2 KM SOUTHWEST OF PHOU VIENG, WHICH IS APPROXIMATELY 20 KM WEST-NORTHWEST OF BOUAM LONG. ONE OF THE RLA POSITIONS FELL INTO COMMUNIST HANDS AND =HEAVY COMBAT= WAS IN PROGRESS AT THE SECOND POSITIONS UNTIL 0730(G) ON 29 JUNE. ALSO, A COMMUNIST UNIT REPORTEDLY BURNED AND COMPLETELY DESTROYED A VILLAGE NEAR BAN NA DIN DENG, 5 KM NORTHEAST OF BOUAM LONG, ON 28 JUNE. XXHH 900
