BT 34 REPORTED THAT 31 POW'S, INCLUDING ONE AMERICAN, WERE AT T-54. THIS IS THE SECOND INDICATION THAT THE PRISONERS HERE LOCATED AT THE 5X COMMO- LIAISON (T) STATION RATHER THAN AT THE T-4X SERIES STATION, AS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED. IT NOW APPEARS THAT THE ARVN AND AMERICAN POW'S WERE AT T-54 ON THE 20TH, AT T-53 ON THE 21ST, AND AT T-52 ON 22 JULY. THE MESSAGE ALSO ALLUDED TO THE PRESENCE OF TWO RAIDERS ON 20 JULY IN THE BT 34 AREA. HOWEVER, THERE WAS NO INFORMATION CONCERNING THEIR STATUS. (2/FIVCJ)748466-71, 22001723) 2.
