 FROM ITS 1 JUNE POSITION AT XD 887 320 (16-34N 106-45E) AND PLACES THIS ENTITY  
 APPROXIMATELY 8 KILOMETERS SOUTHWEST OF FSB TAN LAM BAC (YD 019 593, 16-48N

 REGIMENT, COMMUNICATIONS OF 7 JUNE AMONG UNIDENTIFIED ELEMENTS OF THE 66TH

 070424Z JUN 71) C. UNIDENTIFIED, A COMMUNIQUE OF 8 JUNE BETWEEN UNIDENTIFIED  
 ELEMENTS OF THE NVA 304TH DIVISION REVEALED THAT THE \$STATION\$ AT DONG CHE (YD  
 015 398, 16-37N 106-51E) HAD BROKFS COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT AND THAT THE  
 \$STATION\$ AT 405 (YD 038 424, 16-39N 106-53E) HAD THREE OBSERVERS AND THREE

AT NIGHT, THE COMPANY WILL EMPLOY ONE WEAPON AT KILOMETER 25 AND TWO WEAPONS AT TOM RU. COMPANY 102 WIL MAN, DURING BOTH THE DAY AND NIGHT, ONE WEAPON AT KILOMETER 25 AND ONE WEAPON AT TOM RU.
