1. DMZ AREA ON -4 JUNE N KEEMENTS OF THE NVA 84TH ARTILLERY REGIMENT WERE
PROVIDED FIRING DATA FOR DOC MIEU (A- COMBAT BASE, YD 210745, 76-56N 107-04E)
AND QUAN NGANG JKCJQ COMBAT BASE, YD 273674, 16-53N 107-03EJL IN N RTHEASTERN
QUANR TRI PROVINCE AND WERE ORDERED TO PREPARE TO CONDUCT SUPPRESSIVE FIRE
AGAINST THESE ALLIED POSITIONS. MORE VER, HQJN IRKTH ARTILLERY REGIMENT INFORMED
THE 3D BATALI N HAT I NIRTH DE POSSIBLE TO STRIKE DAI SON ((,2 COMBAT BASE, SD
108? 0, 16-53N 787-0-E WITH 140-MM ROCKETS AND QUAN NGANG WITH -2-MM ROCKETS
JZIN A FEW DAYS. AS ON 24 JUNE, A REGIMENTAL ELEMENT REPORTED THAT NVA FORCES
HAD BEEN ABLE TO OCCUPY FIRE SUPPORT BASE FULLER AND CAPTURE PRISONERS. N -4
JUNE AN ELEMENT OF THE NVA JTWD REGIMENT REPORTED ON ALLIED AIR AND ARTILLERY
ACTIVITY IN THE GENERAL AREA OF CENTRAL QUANG TRI PROVINCE. THE UNIT STATED
THAT \$F4\$ AIRCRAFT BOMBED WEST OF FIRE SUPPORT BASE FULLER FROM 1500 TO 1600(G)
ON 23 JUNE AND THAT ALLIED HELICOPTERS HAD SHELLED THE SURROUNDING AREA. LATER
ON 24 JUNE, ANOTHER ELEMENT OF THE REGIMENT REPORTED THAT ALLIED ARTILLERY AT
CAMP CARROLL FIRED INTO THE AREA NORTH OF HILL 380 (XD 970350, 16-35N 106-50E)
AND TWO ALLIED B-52 AIRCRAFT BOMBED SOUTHEAST OF TIA PONG JKXD 886537, 16-45N
106-46E) AT 1700(G) ON 23 JUNE. (2/F1/VCM/T4120-71, 242215ZJV T4121-71,
242215Z) ~~SECRET SPOKE~~ 2. MILITARY REGION TRI-THIEN-HUE IN CENTRAL QUANG TRI
PROVINCE. N 24 JUNE, ELEMENTS OF THE 66(54 43+8.3.5, NVA 304TH DIVISION REPORTED
KILLING 120 ALLIES AS OF 23 JUNE, INCLUDING NO AMERICAN COMMANDERS. ANOTHER
ELEMENT STATED THAT IT HAD CUT A TRAIL LEADING UP TO KHONG TEN (POSSIBLY AT YD
031481, 16-42N 106-54E) AND HAD ESTABLISHED BLOCKING AND ATTACKING POSITIONS
ALONG THIS TRAIL. ALSO ON 24 JUNE AN ELEMENT OF THE 66TH REGIMENT PROPOSED TWO
PLANS FOR AN ATTACK AGAINST AN UNSPECIFIED TARGET. IN THE FIRST PLAN, 400 TO
500 ROUNDS OF 120-MM MORTAR AND 122-MM ROCKET WOULD HAVE TO BE FIRED TO MAKE
THE ATTACK EFFECTIVE--AN EXPENDITURE THAT THE ELEMENT CONSIDERED EXCESSIVE. THE
ALTERNATE PLAN CALLED FOR THE REINFORCEMENT OF THE 3D BATTALION, 9TH REGIMENT,
304TH DIVISION. THE ADDITION OF ANOTHER BATTALION TO REPLACE TROOP LOSSES; AND
THE FIRING OF 128-MM M RTARS AND 722-MM ROCKETS UPON REQUEST. GROUP 6 ELEMENTS
DISCLOSED PLANS TO ATTACK ALLIED FORCES LOCATED AT HILL 840 (YC 461948, 16-12N
107-77E) IN CENTRAL THUA THIEN PROVINCE. GROUP 6 ELEMENTS WERE ORDERED ON 24 JUNE
TO TAKE UP POSITIONS IN A HUI JKKI SIDS CALLED A SC JRSE EUN USAUUN 787-17E (,

 SWEEP BY AN ARVN INFANTRY BATTALION FROM AN UME TO BEGIN ON THE 26TH NEAR PLEI
 DAC LA (BR 848425, 13-57N 108-15E). OTHER COMMUNICATIONS REVEALED THAT ALL
 PROGNICAL UNIT CADRE ARE TO ATTEND A MEETING AT HQ, 2D BATTALION, GIA LAI PU ON
 26 JUNE. IN SOUTHERN PLEIKU, AN UNIDENTIFIED ENTITY (B2991) HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED
 AS THE 1ST COMPANY, NVA 631ST ARTILERY BATTALION, (2/00/VCM/R278-71, IN
