SITUATION SUMMARY, IN NORTH VIETNAM A D THE DMZ AREA, NO SILNIFICANT ACTIVITY WAS OBSERVEE IN EXPLOITABLE COMMUNICATIONS. IN NORTHERN MR-5, THE HEADQUARTERS, FRONT FOUR, FORWARD ELEMENT ONE REFERENCED ALLIED STRIKES. FINALLY, COMMUNICATIONS SERVING THE GENERAL DIRECTORATE OF REAR SERVICES WERE HIGHLIGHTED BY A REPORT OF A POSSILBE CAPTURE OF TWO PILOTS BY AN UNIDETIFIED NVA REAR SERVICES ELEMENT. I. FURTHER, IT WAS REPORTED THAT ALSO ON 11 JANUARY, THE ENEMY FIRED 601. . 945-47 INTO AN UNKNOWN LOCATION, POS- SIBLY KILLING ONE AND HOUNDI G THREE PERSONS. ADDITIONALLY, IT WAS DISCLOSED THAT ONE COMPNY OF D7 (UNEQUATED DESIGNATOR) AND C57B (NFI) HAD MAS DISCLUSED THAT UNE CUMPNY OF D7 (UNEQUATED DESIGNATOR) AND C57B (NFI) HAD PTSSIBLY DEFENDED QUAN LY (LOCATEE VICINITY BT 165 577, 15-531, 188-21E) WHILE THE \$AMERICA S AT HILH POI T 35Ø\$ (LOCATED VICENITY AT 932 761, 16-82N 188-87E) HAD AN AIR FIELD WITH 23 AIRCRAFT (NFI), INCLUDING HUIA HELI- COPTERS AND LOH HELICOPTERS. FINALLY, IT WAS REVEALED THAT ON AN UNSPECIFIED DATE, THE \$ENEMY\$ HAE CROSSED THE SONG BUNG RIVER AND THE SONG THA H MY RIVER, PTSSIBLY FIRED UNSPECIFIEE ROCKETS AND POSSIBLY DESTROYED A NUMBER OF BOATS, WHILE 185MM ARTILLERY AND 155MM ARTILLERY WERE MENTIONED IN UNCLEAR TEXT ARTILLERY AND 155MM ARTILLERY WERE MENTIONED IN UNCLEAR TEXT.

FURTHER, T WAS REVEALED THAT TY SENEMYS STRIKES HAD BEEN UNSUCCESSFUL.
