HE SAID THAT THESE RUMORS ARE COMPLETELY WITHOUT FOUNDATION AND ARE BUT NONSENSEN, TAKING INTO ACCOUNT THE FACT THAT HE HAD BEEN CONSISTENTLY IN FAVOR OF VIETNAM DURING THE LAST FOUR YEARS AND THAT HE DID NOTITALK TO FRENCH REOPLE ABOUT THE SUBSTANCE OF U.S. POLICY. ATTTHE END OF THE CONVERSATION, WHICH LASTED FOR ALMOST 1 HOURS OR KISSINGER CAME BACK TO THE POINT THAT HOWEVER IMPERECT AN AGREEMENT CAN BE IT IS A NECESSITY FOR THE CONTINUATION OF U.S. SUPPORT. HE SAID THAT HE HOPED THAT PRESIDENT THEU WILL UNDERSTAND ONE THE VITAL NECESSITY FOR VIETNAMESE AND AMERICANS TO STAY CLOSE TOGETHER: AND THO THE VITAL C- VAL NECESS-ITY FOR) SEEING WHERE ARE THE REAL FRIENDS: OF VIETNAM, IMPLYING THAT PRESIDENT NIXON AND HIMSELF ARE THESE REAL FRIENDS) DEFENDING CONSISTENTLY THE CAUSE OF VIETNAM AGAINST ALL THESE LIBERALS WHO WANTED TO GIVE UP A LONG TIME AGO. DR. KISSINGER PROMISED TO SEE US AGAIN IN PARIS BY THE TIME WE REACHED PARIS LATER THIS WEEK. 2. SECRETARY ROGERS AND UNDERSECRETARY ALEXIS: JOHNSON ASKED US TO CONVEY BACK THE MESSAGE THAT "IF WE SUCCEED TO HAVE AN AGREEMENT WITH HANDI AND YOU DECIDE NOT TO GO ALONG WITH US, WE WILL NOT BE IN A POSITION TO SUPPORT YOU BECAUSE HE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO GET CONGRESSIONAL SUPPORT. IT IS AS SIMPLE AS THAT IN HE DISCUSSED ABOUT THE WITHORAWAL OF NORTH VIETNAMESE TROOPS AND AMBASSADOR PHUDING. AS WELL AS DR. DO AND MYSELFS ARGUED THAT IS IS A MATTER OF PRINCIPLES FOR US. TO SUCH AN AGRUEENT, SECRETARY ROGERS. ((SAID)) THAT HE DOES NOT ARGUE ABOUT THE LEGITIMACY OF OUR ARGUMENT, BUT HE THINKS THAT THEY CAN DO (SIC) THAT THEY HAVE NO CHOICE LEFT AND THAT THE PROBLEM IS TO HAVE PRACTICAL CONDITIONS IN VIEW OF SUPPORTING PRINCIPLES. OTHERWISE, IT WILL SERVE NO USEFUL PURPOSE TO HAVE RIGHT PRINCIPLES BUT NO PRACTICAL CONDITIONS TO SUPPORT IT.
UNDERSECRETARY JOHNSON STRESSED HIS CONSTANT SUPPORT IN FAVOR OF ((SOUTH)) VIETNAM BUT EXPRESSED CONCERN ABOUT AN EVENTUAL BREAK BETWEEN THE U.S. AND ((SOUTH)) VIETNAM BECAUSE HE SAID THAT 3. WE GO ON MEETING HITH SENATORS AND NEWSMEN TAKING A VERY CAREFUL APPROACHS DEFENDING STRONGLY DUR CAUSES BUT IN ((SIC)) THE SAME TIME AVOIDING TO TAKE DEFINITE POSITIONS OR TO COMMIT DURSELVES TO ANY PARTICULAR POSITION. 4.
