Six Community Colleges received this designation for years 2010 through 2015. This program was established as a means of providing recognition to institutions that serve as models for two-year institutions by providing innovative, comprehensive and multidisciplinary education and training in the Information Assurance/Cyber Security field.

There are now a total of 106 colleges and universities designated as CAE/IAE and 47 CAE-R. Thirty-six (36) institutions are designated as both CAE/IAE and CAE-R. They are located in 39 states, the District of Columbia and the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico. The top eight states with the most participating institutions are: Texas (9), Pennsylvania (7), Maryland (7), California (6), Illinois (6), New York (6), New Jersey (5) and Georgia (4). With the addition of the six Community Colleges, there are 125 institutions participating in all of the CAE Programs.
