I checked with Miss Weber regarding the relaxation of the restrictions imposed upon your relations with representatives of foreign governments and other agencies, and her recollection agrees with mine with one minor exception.

There was a "record" memorandum prepared summarizing the verbal instructions received, which was filed not in the "Bedbug" folder but in a folder marked "Foreign Representatives".

Lt. Best ought to have no difficulty in putting his hands on it, but if it cannot be found, I will be glad to confirm verbally your understanding of the instructions. I am positive that <u>all</u> restrictions were removed.
