Dear Dr. Wilks:

This is to acknowledge your letter of 22 July 1954, pertaining to the arrangements for your trip to Cheltenham.

It will be necessary for you to sign and fingerprint an AGO Identification Card at the Pentagon prior to your departure from Washington. We are making arrangements for you to do this on 30 August; so, as you suggested, it would be well for you to plan on spending 30 August at NSA, in order to get any necessary preparatory information as well as take care of the issuance of the AGO Card.

Today we received confirmation from MATS on the transportation requested for you. There is no change from the general arrangements described in my letter of 14 July 1954 to you. You will be on Flight A423 on 31 August, which will necessitate your being at National Airport by 10:00 a.m. that day. You will have a 65 pound baggage allowance.

It is noted that you are making your own arrangements on regard to your passport and immunization shots.

We will continue to keep you informed of any developments pertaining to your trip.
