1. At the meeting of NSA's Classification Advisory Panel on 10 February 1955, one topic of discussion was the content of a portion of the attached publication, "Department of the Air Force On-the-Job Training Program - Senior Radio Intercept Operator, JP 29352," an unclassified publication.

2. Your attention, as the NSA member of USCIBEC, is invited to the publication as a whole, and in particular to the last paragraph on page 4-11. This paragraph seems ill-advised from not only the standpoint of security in an unclassified publication but also of accuracy or even of that of an attempt at a modicum of deception which would deceive nobody. The Classification Advisory Panel agreed that this should be brought to the attention of USCIBEC.

3. This manual was brought to my attention by Mr. Callimahos of TNG. He did not know whether the Air Training Command has published other "On-the-job training programs" for other phases of the cryptologic field. This point should also be investigated it seems to me, to ascertain what the Air Training Command has put out on such jobs as traffic analyst, crypt-analyst, etc.
