1. The ettached decusers, "The Effects of Forld Wer II on the Ecourity of U. S. Mavel Communications", has been read with considerable interest. It is an excellent compilation and discussion of Havel cryptographic security during the war.

2. The subject of the classification of THOM meterial has been under discussion at Army Security Agency for some time. It had been the feeling here that all THOM material was TOP SHORET, except such individual items as were specifically excepted by agreement between the British and U. S. services. Recently this matter has been a subject of discussion by USOICO, the result of which was an agreement on a statement of policy which has been forwarded to the British for comment.

3. A minor connect is made with regard to paragraph 4 on page 6. It is stated that the Japanese intercepted all circuits which could be copied. It is recommended that the word "manual" be inserted prior to the word "circuits."

A. It is requested that Army Security Agoncy be furnished four copies of the final publication.
