BRIEF SUMMARY:

Request confirmation of conversation between Lt. Col. P.J. Clark (IDD/A) and Maj. J.W. Roy (ODDI Hq. EUCOM) on 2 February 1948 during which time Lt. Col. Clark conferred with Joint Chiefs of Staff and the following was agreed upon: That the United States Joint services code word INDEX (JANP 299) is the only source of classified code words used to designate plans, operations, etc which are of joint interest to the headquarters of the components of the armed forces and /or the State Department. Code words so used will bear the same classification as those assigned to the operations they represent.

JCS policy regarding use of classified code words has not been changed. JANAP299 is only basic source of classified code words for use of Armed Forces of the United States.
