BRIEF SUMMARY:

A plan for the consolidation of the Army and State Department code rooms at the American Embassy, Moscow, has been prepared by joint consultation between Army and Embassy personnel. In substance the plan provides for certain measures to be taken, one of them being:

State Department Cryptographic personnel will have to be cleared for cryptographic duties by the army before being permitted to view or operate the army equipment.

The Army Security Agency concurs in the consolidation of cryptographic facilities in the letter from MA Moscow.
