Patent Application on Facsimile Encipherment

1 Mr. Hall, In accordance with our telephone Patents Sec. conversation a few days ago, I am Legal Div., sending you herewith a copy of the OCSigO. sketches, description and correspondence relative to certain systems for enciphering facsimile which were conceived and forwarded to the Patent Section a number of years ago. I hope that it is not too late to file ~~one~~ either of both of these systems and, in view of the fact that processing was not started soon after the recommended action of the Patents Board, I would like to suggest that these cases be given some priority if possible. I am particularly interested in the one dated January 24, 1936 because I believe it would be much more practicable than the other in connection with present facsimile systems.
