Storage of Rotors

1. At present, the Materiel Branch has 9,265 boxes of rotors stored in classified storage areas allotted to it.
2. These rotors have had all wiring removed and are, as such, unclassified and unregistered items. It is desirable to remove these rotors from these areas in order to use the space for classified materiel only.
3. The total storage area required for the rotors is 940 cubic feet. The weight is 57,625 pounds.
4. Supply Branch was queried as to the possibility of their storing these items, but inasmuch as these items have no property number, they cannot be handled by that Branch.
5. As discussed in a telephone conversation between Major Faulds and Captain Russo, it is desired to retain these rotors on this Post for possible future emergency use. Such provision as can be made by your office to provide storage space in an unclassified area should insure that any future relocation of these rotors will not be made without prior notification being given to your office and to the Security Division.
