My dear General Churchill:

Carefully noting your letter of the 25th,
I will meet you on arrival, 9:15 A. M. Grand Central Station and if
the train is on time, we can proceed to Riverbank at 9:30 or 9:35,
otherwise, we may have to wait an hour or so.

to have some supplemental messages from Mr. Gherardi. Personally, I
cannot see much point to it but if you deem it advisable and consistent,
I enclose copy of my letter to Mr. Gherardi, stating what was wanted
and which he declined to furnish without being authorized by you.

If you think well of it, it might be well to
have Mr. Gherardi furnish you with these messages as I would like to
gratify the curiosity on the part of my associates.
