Printing Telegraph Cipher Message

1. Several days ago a message prepared by the Cipher Printing Telegraph Station here was sent you for consideration in connexion with your recent claim that you had broken the cipher used in connexion with the printing telegraph apparatus by the United States Government. After the message had been sent to you I sent for the tapes and discovered that an error had been made through the bone-headedness of one of the men in the Cipher Office which makes it highly desirable that this message be returned without any attempt on your part, and consequent waste of time, in attempting to decipher it.

2. I am sending you herewith another message which I have personally had compared so that I am satisfied no errors exist and that you are at liberty to regard it as a message upon which you can direct your efforts with a view to making good your statement that you can break our cipher.

3. The matter of your reported breaking of this cipher is being made the subject of a separate communication.
