We believe that the code machines we purchased in Sweden are dangerous; the documents used in changing keys are unsatisfactory, and they are used excessively. At present, Finnish officers-in-charge are selling these code machines to other countries in Sweden. They have told us that they were able to read part of a London message using this machine. (there are four of these machines in London) in Finland.
