1. According to a very well authenticated intelligence, Major WAGII<sup>a</sup>, the Hungarian Attaché resident in Sweden, and who since he took up his duties last year has had very close relationship with this office, and who has handled general Axis Intelligence in a very masterful way, has now suddenly been recalled to his home country, and is now making preparations to leave.

(Part 2)

Of course, the Major's transfer is the concern of the Hungarian Army and nothing can be done about it here. But in the prosecution of our objectives against Britain and America we have depended upon him a great deal and his transfer at this time is to be regretted.

As far as is consistent we should like to have you do all in your power to have him continued in his office here.

Although I know you are busy and pressed with many duties, we should like to have you take appropriate measures to bring this to the attention of the Hungarian General Staff.
