To the Librarian:

You are requested by the Secretary of War to withdraw from open shelves and general use all books and other materials dealing with explosives, secret inks, and ciphers.

Such materials should not hereafter be available for use while the United States is at war unless the person desiring to use them can satisfy the chief librarian or his designated representative that such use is entirely legitimate.

The names and addresses of all persons making requests to use the material, whether the requests are granted or not, should be furnished promptly to the local office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
