I am very sorry to hear that.
I did not intentionally or deliberately submit false and inaccurate billings for my time and I hope that whatever records are provided to those who determine my access and clearance also include the audio recorded during our
sessions as well as my written responses to you, including my current objection to the IG's tentative conclusion.
I acknowledge that there are discrepancies with the billed time, according to the logs that you shared with me, but I can assure you that any errors on my part were inad/ertent and not intentional misrepresentations of my time. Those logs also show numerous instances (totaling around 30 hours of time!) where I either under-billed my time or worked hours but did not bill any time at all. I believe these instances are proof that clearly show I was not intentionally or deliberately submitting false and inaccurate billings; instead, they reflect just how poor both my record keeping and time keeping systems really were. I understand that the instances reflected solely in the log can appear intentional but when all factors are taken into consideration, the amount of time in question in addition to the lack of clarity with the time keeping policy with
respect to parking and lunch, for example, my unfortunately sloppy record-keeping at the time and the fact that the log also contains numerous and significant under-billings, I think that the discrepancies fall well within an unfortunate yet explainable and understandable rate of error. The discrepancies work out to about 5 hours per week and I believe that falls well within the range of simple misunderstanding and faulty record-keeping and is not a sign of any intentional
malice or fraud. I would also like to point out that since my departure from have maintained much more accurate and error-free records and I attribute this to both my change in record-keeping and the more accurate and clear time keeping systems and policies put in place by
