TEXT: At 1900 hours ((Golf Time)) 04 May the regiment is to move troops to the NGHIA HUNG District unit. In order to ((2 GR G/U)) one company disguised and ((maintain)) secrecy ((1 GR G)) the troops are not to go downtown. At 1900 hours ((Golf Time)) 07 May return to the old emplacement at the state farm. At 1900 hours ((Golf Time)) 11 May transfer the regimental emplacement ((XGM)) encrypted ((means)) to let the state farm director know that one company will be coming and going.

Item 4 Date: 04 May 1964

TO: 14th Battalion, 330th ((Brigade)).

TEXT: at 1900 hours ((Golf Time)) 04 May the battalion is to move back to the (B Validity Southwest) to unite with CHI and DONG. (B Validity while) on the way leave the 14 millimeter ((machine gun)) company to work at the 556th Regiment, 4 kilometers from TIEN HAI. Continue to study. At 1900 hours ((Golf Time)) 07 May return ((2 GR G/U)) to the old emplacement. Comrade, at 1900 hours ((Golf Time)) 11 May this company is to return to the new emplacement ((2 GR G/M)).

TO: 320th Division, 350th Brigade, 213th (C Validity AA (AW)) Regiment, and 330th Brigade.

TEXT: ((XGM)) (B Validity continue) to turn around and go back over your former positions. To receive the pre-flights ((4 GR G/M)) organize the use of P109 ((A)) in order to receive ((the pre-flights)) from 2200 hours to 0100 hours ((Golf Time)) tomorrow. If there are enemy planes, fire in the usual manner ((X GR G/M)). ((A)) R-109 Soviet VHF transceiver.

Item 6 Date: 05 May 1964

TO: 14th Battalion, 330th Division, 350th Brigade, 320th Division, 213th (C Validity AA (AW)) Regiment.

TEXT: The military commanders are to come up to the Military Region Air Defense Command Post to exchange preliminary steps with the political officer and the political commissar concerning the political assignment in guaranteeing the development and the training. Forward any ideas ((on subjects)) other than ((those mentioned above)).

Item 7 Date: 06 May 1964

FR: HUNG

TO: 14th Battalion, 330th Brigade

TEXT: It is agreed that the equipment can be used for one day. Report on the situation of the 14.5 millimeter ((machine gun)) company.

On 08 and 09 ((May)) there is to be a commanders' conference.

Item 8 Date: 12 May 1964

FR: HUNG

TO: 14th Battalion, 320th ((Division)), Comrade LUONG Chief of Staff and Comrade TUT ((Commander)) 14.5 millimeter ((machine gun company)).

TEXT: At exactly 0630 hours ((Golf Time)) 13 May, be

at the 320th ((Division)) ((3 GR G/U)) the executive officer of the 320th ((Division)) to receive the duty of investigating living conditions at the emplacements ((2 GR G/M)) 16 May.

TO: 330th ((Brigade)), 350th ((Brigade)), 320th ((Division)), and 213th (C Validity AA (AW)) ((Regiment)).

TEXT: From 2400 hours to 0400 hours ((Golf Time)) to-night, all units, ((during)) the (B Validity second) watch, must pay attention for ((enemy)) reconnaissance ((aircraft)) in the sky. Prepare to fight. Published as 2/G9/VHM/T10-64.

TO: ((14th Battalion, 330th Brigade, 350th Brigade, 320th Division, 213th (C Validity AA (AW) Regiment))

TEXT: ((In regard to)) the call signs and frequencies ((used by)) the air defense commands with headquarters, the following is to be implemented on 21 May: From 0600 hours to 2000 hours ((Golf Time)) the Day Frequency is to be used; from 2000 hours to 0600 hours ((Golf Time)) the Night Frequency is to be used. The Evening Frequency is to be deleted. The call-signs are to remain in use.

TO: ((14th Battalion)), 320th ((Division)).

TEXT: The two previously mentioned aircraft are ours.

TO: 14th Battalion, 330th ((Brigade)); 14th Battalion, 213th (C Validity AA (AW)) Regiment, 320th ((Division))

TEXT: The units are to report immediately the developments of last evening, 31 May, and the activities of the units in regard to (C Validity overflights) ((with)) objectives in ((your area of)) activity.

At 0100 hours ((Golf Time)) receive ((2 GR G/U)) message ((3 GR G)). At exactly 1900 hours ((Golf Time)) you must report back to the Military Region Air Defense Command Post immediately in order to report along with the commanders.

TO: 213th (C Validity AA(AW)) Regiment.

TEXT: On the afternoon of 03 June I will come down to work with Comrade RIEU and Comrade CAT ((on these problems)): one party conference; the deployment of cadres; attendance of the transportation schools; arrangements for cadre to inspect the work; deployment of the emplacements and implementation of watch procedure ((for)) firing training.

This communique is to let the units know that the ((above)) work must be completed by 05 June.

TEXT: ((XGM)) we are already aware of the new coordinates of the map ((XGM)) At 1900 hours ((Golf Time)) 26 ((April)) ((XGM/G)) of the Air Defense must return to the Brigade to request ((it)). Only then can it be obtained. From 1800 hours ((Golf Time)) 25 ((April)) to 1400 hours ((Golf Time)) 26 ((April)) there was an alert for an enemy aircraft. The unit was unable to do anything.

Item 4 Date: 28 April 1964

FR: NGUYEN VIET HUNG

TEXT: We are studying the mission in accordance with the program.

At 0815 hours ((Golf Time)) 27 ((April)) there were loud sounds and message number three was missed.

(C Validity Overflights) one, three and five were out of range of the map. Only (C Validity overflight) five was within the map of the 17th Battalion ((by)) 5 kilometers. On the ground it was calm.

On 28 April 1964 at 0814 hours ((Golf Time)) (C Validity overflight) three ((is scheduled)) ((and)) (C Validity overflight) four at 0848 hours ((Golf Time)) 200 kilometers ((away. The battle watch ((will be)) executed strictly and exactly.

TEXT: All the Battalions are prepared for the struggle on 01 May. ((Remainder of the message corrupt))

Item 6 Date: 02 May 1964

FR: NGUYEN VIET HUNG

TEXT: -The unit is studying the mission in accordance with the program.

At 0935 hours ((Golf Time)) an enemy aircraft appeared in the sky. ((soon)) after that the observation station discovered they had a selection of a ((scheduled)) aircraft in the distance. They reported all calm at 0945 hours ((Golf Time)). ((With)) all calm on the ground they properly and strictly executed the regulations. Warmest Regards.

Item 7 Date: 05 May 1964

FR: HUNG

TEXT: ((XGM)) cannot come down to guarantee security. I suggest the Military Region allow us to use the equipment for one day.

Item 8 Date: 11 May 1964

FR: LUU VAN KIEN

TEXT: ((This is)) the situation of the fight preparations to guarantee ((XGM)) the enemy in the air for the past few days. At 09 (B Validity 30) hours ((Golf Time)) on ((1GRM)) May there were ((XGM)) on 08, 09, and 10 May all were 150 kilometers or more away from the emplacement.

On 09 May the unit experienced rain from 0200 hours ((Golf Time)) in the morning until 0600 hours ((Golf Time)). The entire unit was unable to sleep. On the evening of 10 May it rained from night until morning, water flooded the position and this is to report that all companies suffered rain soaking. The health of the unit has been affected.

Item 9 Date: 12 May 1964

FR: LUU VAN KIEM

TEXT: In accordance with the plan the 14.5 millimeter ((machine gun)) company moved the troops and transferred the emplacement at exactly 1900 hours ((Golf Time)) 11 May. Because of the rain the road was dangerously slippery and a vehicle overturned at 2050 hours ((Golf Time)). One comrade was seriously injured and one comrade died. He could not be saved. At the present time, the movement of troops has been delayed, on the morning of 12 May a specific report will be made.

Item 10 Date: 12 May 1964

FR: LUU VAN KIEN

TEXT: The ((vehicle)) overturned from the top of a high road down into a ditch in the direction of the ricefield, the water (B Validity level) was one meter deep. Comrade TR((1GRU)) VAN CHAT ((TR((1GRU)) VAWN CHAATS)) ((B)) ((WHO)) began work in October 1963 is dead. Two other comrades were seriously injured - one broke his arm and the other broke his leg. Another comrade is unsteady and cannot speak. The vehicle is damaged and will be difficult to pull out. Comrade VIET ((VIEETJ)) ((C)), the battalion commander, was in the above vehicle but had no trouble. Suggest the Military Region forward its opinions.

Item 11 Date: 12 May 1964

FR: LUU VAN KIEN

TEXT: Herewith a confirmed report on the accident:

One comrade is dead and three are injured, one seriously, two lightly. ((XGM)) comrades arm ((XGM)) The comrade that suffered serious head injuries and a (B Validity sprained) foot has already ((XGM)), by midnight ((2GRG/U)), the comrade with the injured arm had been taken to the unit for aid.

Their vehicle was pulled out at 1000 hours ((Golf Time)) the ((next)) morning. It was only slightly damaged and was still able to run. The dents in the vehicle were pushed out and mended on the spot it overturned. Their vehicle has been fixed sufficiently to work as before and can resume the transport duties around the region ((XGM)). At exactly 2000 hours ((Golf Time)) the above unit will occupy a new emplacement, the immediate task is to mobilize the unit. Then it can proceed to TIEN DONG.

Item 12 Date: 13 May 1964

FR: VIET HUNG

TEXT: The circumstances involving company 48, a 14.5 millimeter ((machine gun company)), have been resolved. The vehicle has been brought back to the new battalion emplacement.

At 1900 hours ((Golf Time)) 12 May the unit continued with the study mission.

The Battalion has directed Company 48 to carry out ((the gathering)) of statistics for lost or damaged weapons, military equipment and military supplies and report back to the Military Region later.

On 15 May the Battalion will follow with an order for the vehicle to go ((8GRG/M/U)) The emplacement terrain for the 14.5 ((machine gun)) Company. The region was exposed to much rain which covered the road with water making movements difficult.

Item 13 Date: 25 May 1964

FR: HUNG

TEXT: The unit is studying the mission in accordance with the program ((XGM)) An enemy aircraft appeared at a range of 7 kilometers at an altitude of ((1GRM)) 5 kilometers, it could not be observed ((XGM/U)) calm and the 14.5 millimeter ((machine gun)) Company ran its military operation according to the plan that the region had stipulated. There was/is no ((2GRG)) at all.

TEXT: ((XGM)) let us know clearly the coordinates so that we can search in the right ((spot)) ((XGRM/G)) one to 100,000. I suggest you let us know right away so that the search ((can begin))

FR: DAU VO

TEXT: There is nothing special to report on the air-ground situation.

The 14.5 millimeter ((machine gun)) company will occupy emplacement two on the evening of 28 May.

Item 4 Date: 29 April 1964

TEXT: There is nothing special to report on the air-ground situation.

The machine gun company has already occupied the emplacement ((4 GR G/U)) for the chart ((to establish)) communications.

Item 5 Date: 01 May 1964

VII. COMMENTS

An effort has been made to keep the evaluation of this material to a minimum, thus allowing an unbiased interpretation to be made.

The following words and phrases, however, deserve a short explanation:

To study - As found in the context of these messages has the connotation of a practical matter.

(Charlie Validity overflight) - The action described, i. e. to fly over or be above, is Alfa Validity, but because the exact Vietnamese term is unknown it is required that we give the English rendering a Charlie Validity.

Operations - This could be rendered literally combat, however, as it is observed in relation to command it has been extended to operations and qualified here.

To struggle/fight - This can mean in other context to make an all out effort. Here it is believed to carry the military connotation.


