ADDITIONAL INFORMATION NOTED IN COMINT AT 0710Z ON 24 JANUARY INDICATES THAT THE NEW TYPES OF EQUIPMENT ABOARD THE PUEBLO WERE DESTROYED. IT WAS MENTIONED THAT THE WONSAN BASE COMMANDER WOULD IDENTIFY THE REMAINING EQUIPMENT AT THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE TIME. AND THAT THE DIRECTOR OF THE OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT AND THE CHIEF OF FIRE POWER DIVISION WERE CONDUCTING A SEARCH OF THE SHIP SINCE YESTERDAY, AND ALSO THAT THE CHIEF OF THE SECURITY DEPARTMENT WAS THERE SINCE YESTERDAY.

IT WAS ALSO NOTED THAT THE COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF WAS GOING TO DEPART FOR WONSAN THAT NIGHT.

IT WAS ALSO MENTIONED THAT THE CHIEF OF COMMUNICATIONS AND THE CHIEF OF THE SECURITY DEPARTMENT WERE AT THE LOCATION SINCE THE PREVIOUS DAY, APPARENTLY INSPECTING THE EQUIPMENT LEFT ABOARD THE SHIP. ELECTRONIC CALCULATORS AND A MACHINE THAT STARTS ALL OTHER EQUIPMENT, WHICH WAS ALSO MENTIONED, APPARENTLY FELL INTO THE HANDS OF THE NORTH KOREANS.

IT WAS ALSO MENTIONED THAT THEY (APPARENTLY THE U.S.) KNOW THE LOCATION WHERE THE SHIP WAS CAPTURED AND THAT THEY NOW WOULD SEND OUT THE FIRST TEAM OF DIVZRS AND GET READY FOR THE SAL-
