SERES<sup>[1]</sup> gives excellent personal reports on Tomo BABURICH and Pave POTSRNICH<sup>[11]</sup>. He knows both of them well and considers that they deserve complete confidence. One can get in touch by mentioning his name with the condition that the instructions of our man are followed. In order to prove the existence of contact with SERES [1 group unrecovered] BABURICH that in the years 1928-1930 he was sent to SERES's house at VUKOVA GORITSA<sup>[111]</sup> in Germany where he met MACHEK<sup>[1v]</sup>.
