Subject:            The Potentialities of COMINT for Strategic Warning (Report of Special Study Group NSASAB) (Robertson Report).

GENERAL CANINE recalled that he had forwarded the so-called Robertson Report on limited distribution to USCIB members last October. He explained that this report, dealing primarily with the Early Warning Problem, had been prepared at his request by Dr. H. P. Robertson, who had come up with a list of recommendations for improvement in various COMINT-producing practices and procedures.

He reviewed briefly the major recommendations of the report and outlined actions already taken, and those contemplated, in implementation of these recommendations. He informed the members that a detailed report on the subject will be distributed in the near future, adding that he merely wished, at this juncture, to notify all concerned that the matter is receiving attention.

The members noted the information presented by the Director, NSA.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 1605, at which time the members remained for an Executive Session, called at the request of the Director, NSA.
