MEMORANDUM FOR THE MEMBERS OF USCIB:

Subject: Implementation of USCIB Directive No. 9.

1. Although reference (a) indicated that the "Security Requirements" ultimately approved as presented in reference (b) were originally intended as an initial effort in the development of minimum standards for the purpose of subject Directive, all members have now approved reference (c) which action has the effect of establishing reference (b) as the minimum standards themselves.

2. Reference (d) notified members that they were not expected to conduct the inspections required by subject Directive until minimum standards had been established.

3. Accordingly Members are now requested to commence the inspections and submit the reports required by SECTION III of subject Directive as soon as practicable.
