Subject: COMINT Relations with Third Parties [redacted]

1. The following tentative record of decision reached by USCIB at its 102nd Meeting on Friday, 9 April 1954 with relation to item 1 of the agenda of that meeting is circulated herewith in advance of the minutes for the convenience of the members:

"USCIB agreed that:

a. A U.S.-U.K. conference should be held in London, in July, to discuss [redacted]


b. ELINT should not be included on the agenda for such conference at this time.

c. A working committee should be convened under the cognizance of the Director, National Security Agency to prepare recommendations to USCIB for an agenda and a delegation for the above mentioned conference.

d. The working group mentioned in subparagraph c. above should have the recommendations ready for consideration at the Special Meeting now scheduled for Friday, 23 April 1954.

e. The members should notify the Executive Secretary of the names of persons to participate in the above mentioned working group.

f. The Executive Secretary should take action to have forwarded to the Chairman, LSIB the draft memorandum included as enclosure 3 to NSA serial 000156 § of 4 April 1954 which was circulated as the enclosure to USCIB 29.17/3."
