1. DD/PRODUCTION

Reported that construction work at AHS on the new Briefing Room in "B" Building and changes in the basement of the Cafeteria are progressing very well.

2. COMPTROLLER

Advised that the Office of the Comptroller has begun the budget review for Fiscal Year 1956.

3. TRAINING

Announced that Dr. A. Sinkov (PROD) will enter the National War College and Mr. Paul Neff (COMP) will enter the Industrial College of the Armed Forces this September. Mr. Kenneth Kuhn (COMSEC) will attend Cornell University for six weeks of special study.

4. COMMUNICATIONS

Repeated an invitation to the Staff to submit to him any communications problems which he could look into on his forthcoming visit to field stations. The Chief, COM, will be on tour through the UK, Europe, and the Mediterranean area during the next two months.

5. DIRECTOR
